

## **THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FOLLY CANAL BRIDGE) SCHEME 2009**

The Lancashire County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) make this Scheme in exercise of their powers under section 106(3) of the Highways Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf.

1. The Council are authorised to construct over the navigable waters of the Lancaster Canal the bridge specified in the Schedule to this Scheme as part of the highway which they are proposing to construct between the M6 Motorway at Junction 34, Halton and the highway known as A683 Morecambe Road, Torrisholme, Lancashire in the District of Lancaster in the said County.
2. This Scheme may be cited as The Lancashire County Council (Folly Canal Bridge) Scheme 2009.

**THE SCHEDULE TO THE SCHEME**

**PLAN AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE BRIDGE**

The location and general design of the Bridge are shown on the attached plans.

**POINTS OF COMMENCEMENT AND TERMINATION**

From a point on the west bank of Lancaster Canal 337 metres north east of Barley Cop Railway Bridge located at the intersection of the unclassified road U18491 Barley Cop Lane and the West Coast Main Railway Line.

To a point on the east bank of the Lancaster Canal 395 metres north east of Barley Cop Railway Bridge located at the intersection of the unclassified road U18491 Barley Cop Lane and the West Coast Main Railway Line.

**SPAN**

A single skew span of 20.37 metres and a square span of 20.00 metres.

**HEADWAY**

Not less than 2.7metres above the overflow weir level of 21.06metres AOD.

**WATERWAY**

A minimum clear navigable waterway of 12.10 metres.

**OVERALL DIMENSIONS**

The Bridge will be 36.0 metres wide overall and will carry a 7.3 metre wide dual carriageway, with 1.0 metre wide hard strips, segregated by a 2.5 metre wide raised central reserve. There will be a 2.5 metre minimum wide raised verge on the north west of the Bridge and a 3.5 metre minimum wide combined footway and cycleway on the south-east side of the Bridge.
