

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (TORRISHOLME TO THE M6 LINK (A683 COMPLETION OF HEYSHAM TO M6 LINK ROAD) CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2009

The Lancashire County Council hereby give notice that they have made and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation an Order under sections 14, 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980

Authorising the council to:

improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering);

stop-up highways;

construct new highways;

stop-up private means of access to premises; and

provide new means of access to said premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road to be known as the Torrisholme to the M6 Link (A683 Completion of Heysham to M6 Link) which the Council are proposing to construct between the junction of the A589/A683 Morecambe Road near Torrisholme and junction 34 of the M6 motorway.
