**PUBLIC INFORMATION NOTICE
 EAVES GREEN LINK CHORLEY**

The County Council as the Highway Authority has awarded the above contract to Birse Civils Ltd, part of the Balfour Beatty Group to construct the Link Road.

The work will commence on Monday 4 December and programmed to be complete in Autumn 2007.

The scheme has been designed and will be project managed by staff from the Environment Directorate.

One of the first operations will be to resurface a substantial length of Lower Burgh Way with low noise surfacing prior to allowing contractor 's plants using the road to access the construction site. Properties in vicinity of Lower Burgh Way will benefit from immediate reduction in noise levels generated by passing vehicles.

Major road schemes such as this Link Road will inevitably cause some inconvenience and delay and wherever possible, these will be kept to a minimum.


