(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

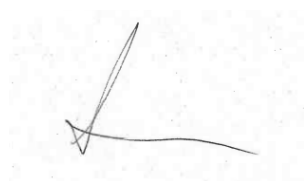
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Long Moss Lane, Whitestake from its junction with Moss Lane, New Longton to its junction with Wholesome Lane, Longton.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 27th July 2026 until 1700 hours on Friday 31st July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Long Moss Lane – Brownhill Lane – Chapel Park Road – Chapel Lane – Moss Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow replacement works to be carried out to replace a damaged fire hydrant.
