

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BLACKBURN ROAD, PADIHAM, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(BUS STOP CLEARWAY (4) (2500IMG2575))



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to introduce the above Bus Stop Clearway. Following consultation carried out between 24th April 2026 and 22nd May 2026, it is now intended to modify the proposal as titled above, as set out below.

1. Remove the previously proposed bus stop clearway in Blackburn Road, Padiham, the north side, from a point 4 metres east of its junction with the Centreline of Vicarage Avenue for a distance of 17 metres in a north easterly direction.
2. Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in Blackburn Road Padiham, the north-west side, from a point 9 metres northeast of its junction with the Centreline of Arbories Avenue for a distance of 27 metres in a north easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

Following consideration of objections and representations received during the consultation process, it is proposed to amend the original scheme by relocating the bus stop approximately 64 metres north-east of its currently proposed position and increasing the length of the Bus Stop Clearway from 17 metres to 27 metres.

The revised location has been selected to minimise the impact on existing on-street parking provision while continuing to provide an accessible and convenient stopping point for bus passengers. The extension of the Bus Stop Clearway is necessary to ensure sufficient kerbside space for buses to enter, stop, and rejoin the carriageway safely and efficiently. The proposal will improve the reliability and safety of bus operations by maintaining unobstructed access to the stop and reducing the potential for conflicts with parked vehicles.

The restrictions are therefore considered necessary to facilitate the safe and efficient movement of public transport, while balancing the needs of residents and other road users.
