(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

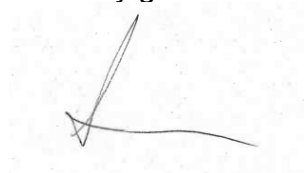
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Red Lane, Eccleston from a point 35 metres east of its junction with Bradley Lane, Eccleston to its junction with Alder Hall, Charnock Richard.
 - II. Back Lane, Charnock Richard from its junction with Alder Hall, Charnock Richard to its junction with Mill Lane Track, Charnock Richard.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 4th August 2026 until 1700 hours on Saturday 15th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Back Lane - A49 Preston Road – Mill Lane – Park Hall Road - B5250 Wood Lane - B5250 Langton Brow - B5250 The Green – Parr Lane – Red Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow replacement, and installation works to be carried out.
