

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STANIFIELD LANE, LOSTOCK HALL, SOUTH RIBBLE
BOROUGH) (INTRODUCTION AND REMOVAL OF BUS
STOP CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

- 1) Remove bus stops in the Stanifield Lane, Lostock Hall, both sides, from a point 154 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Stoney Lane.
- 2) Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Stanifield Lane, Lostock Hall, the east side, from a point 97 metres south of its roundabout junction with Farington Road for a distance of 27 metres in a southerly direction;
 - b) Stanifield Lane, Lostock Hall, the west side, from a point 48.8 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Stoney Lane for a distance of 26.5 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 agreement under the Highways Act 1980. These proposals are being funded fully by the development linked to the new cricket ground and the future housing development and the associated planning conditions.

The proposals include the removal and relocation of the existing bus stops to more suitable positions and to support their upgrade to quality bus stops. This is to allow the buses to pull in and out safely and allow for effective enforcement.

A raised boarding platform will also be installed to ensure safe boarding and alighting of mobility impaired passengers and ensure the bus stops are fully mobility compliant. Bus shelters are also to be provided.
