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Introduction and methodology

Introduction

This service mapping exercise forms part of the larger teenage pregnancy needs assessment for Lancashire. The needs assessment was suggested as a priority area of work for the Intelligence for Healthy Lancashire (IHL) group in 2010. The Joint Strategic Needs Assessment team established a project group and led on the project following agreement with the IHL leadership group, which is composed of the three Lancashire Directors of Public Health and the Lancashire Directors of Adult and Children's Social Care. Although the Lancashire JSNA is provided for the County footprint, in line with the upper tier authority, the needs assessment was conducted in partnership with Blackburn with Darwen and Blackpool due to the efficiencies involved in completing the analysis.

Methodology

Population density – females 15-17

The background layer for the maps in this report shows the number of females aged 15-17 years per square mile in each electoral ward. The mid-2007 ward level population estimates were used for this and the 15-17 age group was calculated as three fifths of the published 15-19 age band.

Teenage conceptions data

This report uses under 18 conceptions data from the Teenage Pregnancy Unit (TPU). Conception Statistics are produced by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) and are a well established statistical series that are compiled by combining information from birth registrations and abortion notifications. Conception statistics include pregnancies that result in:

- One or more live or still births; or
- A legal abortion under the Abortion Act 1967

Miscarriages and illegal abortions are not included

Teenage Pregnancy Unit hotspots

Every year the TPU identifies hotspot wards where the rate of teenage conceptions is within the top 20% nationally. The threshold rates were as follows:

- 2004-06 >53.4%
- 2005-07 >53.3%
- 2006-08 >53.1%

For the purposes of this report, any ward within Lancashire which was identified as a TPU hotspot for all three periods has been termed a 'TPU persistent hotspot'.

Statistically significant hotspots

Due to the small numbers involved in teenage conceptions data, the confidence intervals around the rates are very large. Dramatic fluctuations are therefore commonplace, so in order to calculate truly significant values; we class any rate for which the confidence interval does not overlap with the national confidence interval as 'statistically significant'. The confidence level is 95%, so we are saying that if the confidence intervals do not overlap we are 95% certain that the rate for a ward is higher than the national average.

Once again, for the purposes of this report, any ward within Lancashire which had a statistically significantly different rate to the national average for all three periods has been termed a 'statistically significant persistent hotspot'. We can be 95% confident that these areas experience high rates of teenage conceptions.

Sexual health services

Sexual health services may be classed as either:

Level 1 – non-clinical services

Level 2 – those requiring clinical staff

Condom distribution schemes - these provide condoms to young people and basic information and signposting but don't offer level 1 or level 2 sexual health services. However, some clinics offering level 1 or 2 services may also be part of a condom distribution scheme.

Sexual health services may offer any or all of the following:

- Simple Contraception
 - Advice
 - Sexual history taking
 - Condoms
 - Depo Provera (contraceptive injection)
 - Combined Oral Contraceptive pill
 - Progestogen only pill
 - Pregnancy testing and advice
 - Chlamydia (opportunistic screen)
- Complex Contraception
 - Sub-dermal implants
 - Intra Uterine Contraceptive devices (IUCD's) / Intra Uterine System (IUS) (coil)

- Removal of sub-dermal implants, IUCD's and IUS
- Complex cases, for example where there is a difficult medical history, making choice of contraception difficult
- Complex Screen
 - Asymptomatic and symptomatic screening, to include:
 - HIV Test
 - Gonorrhoea
 - Treatment
 - Partner notification
- GUM
 - Symptomatic screening
 - HIV treatment and Care
 - Testing and treatment of all Sexually Transmitted infections
 - Partner notification
 - Complex cases

GP practice services

Under the current contract, GP practices, provide general medical services and are also commissioned to provide Directed Enhanced Services (DESs) or Locally Enhanced Services (LES's). DES's are special services or activities provided by GP practices that have been negotiated nationally. Practices can choose whether or not to provide these services. Contraception is an example of a DES and the majority of GP's provide contraception. In addition, GP practices may be invited to provide a LES, (Local Enhanced Service agreed between PCT commissioners and GPs) an example of this would be an Enhanced STI Service.

GP practices may offer any or all of the following sexual health services:

- Enhanced STIs, offering asymptomatic and some symptomatic screening
- Contraception DES/LES
- Sub-dermal implants and IUCD and IUS

Pharmaceutical services

Increasingly Pharmacies are providing health services that are in addition to the NHS Community Pharmacy Contract.

Report title

Pharmacies may offer any or all of the following sexual health services:

- Emergency Hormonal Contraception (EHC)
- Condoms
- Chlamydia screening

Background and context

Local context

Part of the contribution to the work of the JSNA is to reflect on current service provision in terms of the national initiative to reduce teenage conceptions. The analysis by the JSNA will support a review of all Contraceptive and Sexual Health Services to assess;

- Service placement against teenage pregnancy hotspots
- Assessment of initiatives in wards with statistically significant reduction in teenage conceptions
- Address service gaps
- Address duplication of services as part of a value for money exercise

The mapping conducted for this needs assessment has been completed with the intention of providing a standard and consistent picture of sexual health services for young people over the sub-region of Lancashire. However, during the mapping process the project team highlighted that the provision of sexual health services is complex and responsive to local need. This section provides a summary of the complexities unique to each primary care trust area in terms of its services.

Blackpool – coterminous with the unitary authority

NHS Blackpool commission Connect, the young people's sexual health service, which is based in the town centre, and in two satellite centres known as QA and Reach, which are located next to secondary schools. These services provide contraceptive clinics, counselling, advice and information.

Mobile provision for young people is provided through the Buzz Bus, which targets schools and colleges with limited sexual health provision and areas where young people may find difficulty accessing a clinic.

The GUM department, Contraceptive Services and the Blood Bourne Virus (BBV) team are all based within Whitegate Health Centre.

There are 3 Tier 2 practices; Waterloo Medical Centre, Gorton Street Practice and North Shore Surgery (both Holmfield Road & Bispham Road). All Tier 2 services offer specialised sexual health clinics, providing contraception and STI Screening.

SHIVER (Sexual Health, HIV & Emergency Responses) raises awareness of the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community, focusing on meeting their sexual health needs and offering HIV related services.

Blackburn with Darwen – coterminous with the unitary authority

Central Lancashire – encompassing Chorley, Preston, South Ribble and West Lancashire local authorities

NHS Central Lancashire comprises of four districts: Chorley, Preston, South Ribble and West Lancashire and is made up of rural areas, densely populated areas, affluent areas and areas of significant deprivation, some of which are in the 20% most deprived wards in England.

There are around 65,000 young people aged between 15 and 24 years living in the patch which is broken down into:

- 12,200 living in Chorley
- 24,200 living in Preston
- 12,600 living in South Ribble
- 14,700 living in West Lancashire

There is an even split of young people aged 15 -24 years living in Chorley, South Ribble and West Lancashire but there are more 20 -24 year olds living in Preston :14,700 compared with 9,500 15 – 19 year olds. (Source: ONS mid -2009 population estimates)

Central Lancashire boasts two universities: University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) and Edge Hill together with four Further Education Colleges: Preston, Cardinal Newman, Runshaw, and Skelmersdale & Ormskirk

In addition to the services tabled below, there is an established pharmacy EHC/ chlamydia scheme across the patch, GP sexual health service provision and a range of Level 1 services within young people's community settings.

East Lancashire – encompassing Burnley, Hyndburn, Pendle, Ribble Valley and Rossendale local authorities

Background

In 2005 The Department of Health (DoH) issued Choosing Health funding allocations for sexual health teamed with key performance indicators. For NHS East Lancashire this has resulted in increased investment in Contraceptive and Sexual Health (CaSH) services over the past 5 years.

However, attention to target performance and service growth has left less time to reflect on service outcomes, outputs and value for money.

Whilst the JSNA was originally planned to enable further redesign work to enable reduced rates of conception, NHS East Lancashire will also now use this document as a tool to contribute to Value for Money initiatives. This document will be used to understand where and which services have the most impact in reduction of teenage conceptions. It will also help us to understand where cost savings could potentially be made with minimal risk to the health and social need of young people.

Some of the Contraceptive and Sexual Health (CaSH) service contracts are historic and on initial assessment there appears to be a web of different providers delivering similar services.

Contraceptive and Sexual Health provision delivered at Levels 1 and 2 may be perceived as complex with regards to patient pathway and transition because of this.

The table below sets out the different service providers and their areas of delivery due to historic contractual arrangements. These services are in addition to those provided by GP and Pharmacies. Although some of these services are marketed as ‘adult’ services, young people aged 18 are known to attend these services.

North Lancashire – encompassing Fylde, Lancaster and Wyre local authorities

Geographical Picture

NHS North Lancashire is a geographically large and diverse area, comprising three localities, Lancaster, Wyre and Fylde. It includes rural areas, densely populated areas, affluent areas and areas of significant deprivation. Within the boundaries of NHS North Lancashire there are two large colleges, two universities, two army bases and three prisons.

Lancaster has a younger age-profile than the other districts, with the largest age band being 20-24 year olds. There is a positive correlation between poor sexual health and deprivation. According to the Index of Multiple Deprivation ranking of Local Authorities, Lancaster is the most disadvantaged, with Fylde being the most affluent.

When looking more closely at deprivation, 18 of the 33 wards in North Lancashire are in the 20% most deprived wards in England. These 18 wards also have teenage pregnancy rates which are higher than the national average.

The black and minority ethnic (BME) population in North Lancashire is 2.9%. This is much lower than the national average of 11.7%. The largest BME groups in North Lancashire are: White–Non British/Irish followed by Asian and Chinese. The greatest concentrations of BME groups are in areas providing education, i.e. Lancaster University, University of Cumbria and Fleetwood Nautical College. There are also a number of licensed gypsy and traveller pitches in the Morecambe and Lancaster areas.

Sexual Health Services

The legacy from the former PCTs has resulted in inequitable services, with some gaps in service provision, most notably in Lancaster and Morecambe. GUM opening hours are limited in this area.

Community contraception services are provided by NHS North Lancashire Provider Services and NHS Blackpool Provider Services. In the main these services are provided for all ages, with designated commissioned services for young people being limited to 12 hours a week. The young people services are boosted by the provision of services in the Blackpool area, to which North Lancashire populations attend. The services provided within, Blackpool Wyre and Fylde and Lancaster and Morecambe Colleges and the specific Outreach Service provision enables greater access for young people.

The recent development of a young persons (up to 19) condom scheme has extended level one services for young people into 60 different settings across the PCT area. Termination of pregnancy services also provides a full range of contraception, including long acting methods.

North Lancashire has 39 general practices and a total registered female population (15-49) of 75,268. The 39 practices employ the equivalent of 165 full time health care professionals, of whom 29% (47) provide Intrauterine Contraceptive Devices and 17% (28) provide sub dermal implants.

According to the information PCTs provided to NHS North West through the Improving Access to Contraception monitoring system initiated in 2009, North Lancashire has lower than average rates of uptake of hormonal contraception among 15-17s in the North West. Of this, the LARC uptake, at 24.9 per 1000, is lower than the regional average of 46.9 per 1000. The non-LARC uptake, of 114.2 per 1000, is also lower than the regional average of 187.9

It should be noted that this is data was for one year and only included data collected from sexual health services. The low levels of uptake within sexual health services are mitigated by the higher levels within primary care. According to data on the Balanced Sexual Health Scorecard, contraception usage within primary care is greater than the England, Regional and Lancashire average.

The pharmacy scheme for Emergency Hormonal Contraception was implemented five years ago. During the course of the last five years, analysis indicates that GP prescribing of EHC has reduced

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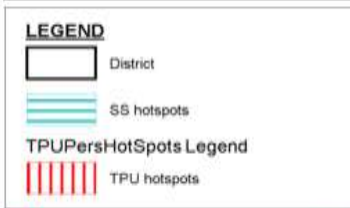
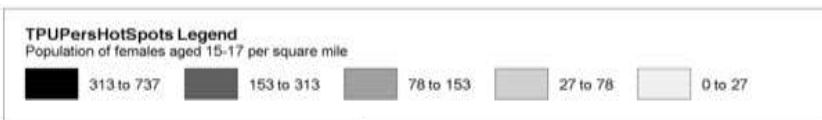
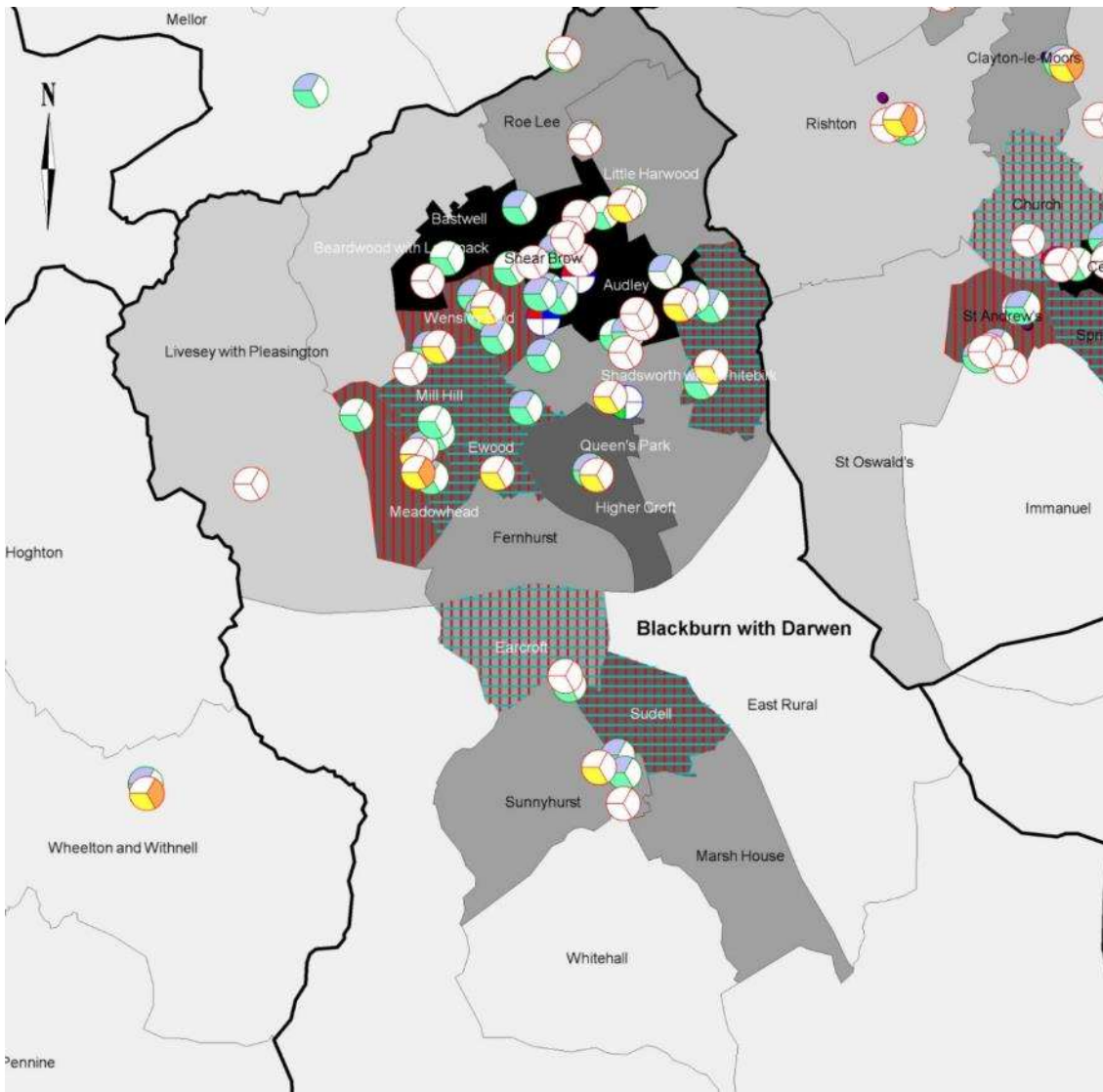
by almost 33%. Though, overall the NHS North Lancashire has seen a 31% increase in usage of EHC since the introduction of the Pharmacy EHC scheme.

Under 18 conceptions persistent hotspots and all nearby services

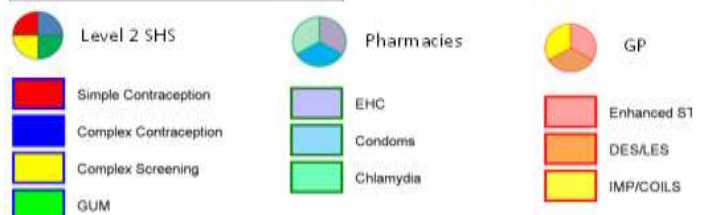
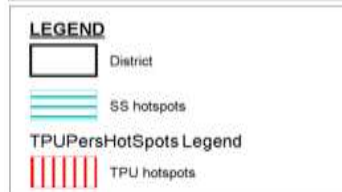
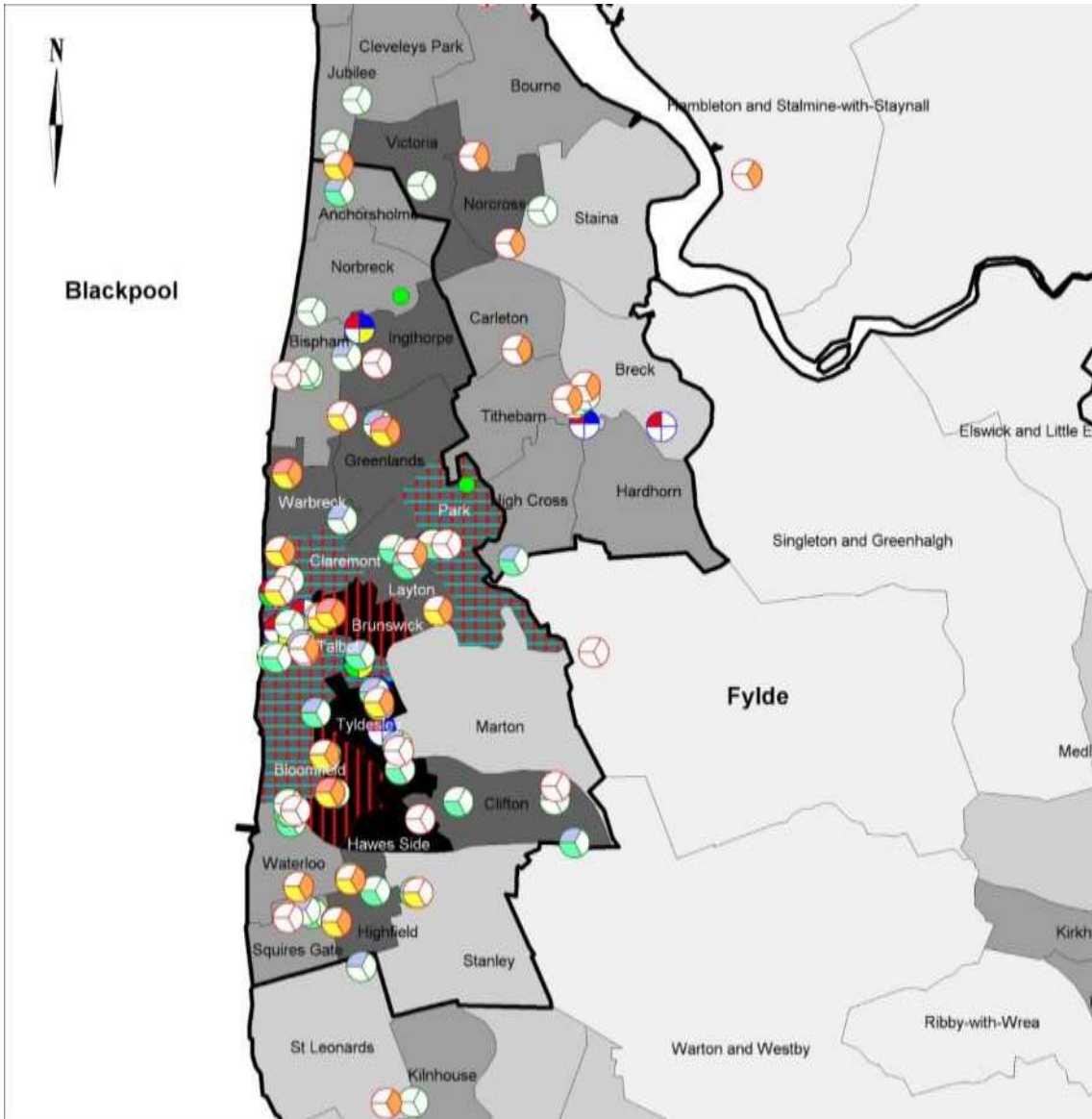
This section focuses in on clusters of TPU and statistically significant persistent hotspots and pinpoints all nearby services to give a picture of the full cache of services on offer. All of the hotspot areas are covered by the maps. There were no persistent hotspot wards in Fylde, Ribble Valley or Wyre for the pooled 2004-06, 2005-07 and 2006-08 data, hence no maps for these areas in this section.

The maps look at the proximity of services to teenage conceptions hotspots in order to identify areas where teenagers would have to travel a long distance (generally by foot or public transport where available) to reach them. The maps not only show the location of each venue but also give an indication of the different types of sexual health services they offer, for example condoms, contraception, genitourinary medicine or emergency hormonal contraception. The base layer for the maps is the population density of females aged 15-17. Wards with a high density of the 'at risk' population may have greater need for services whether they are currently a teenage pregnancy hotspot or not.



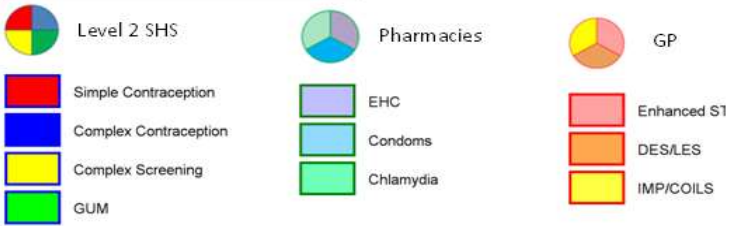
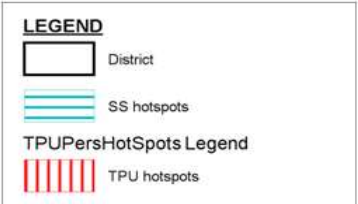
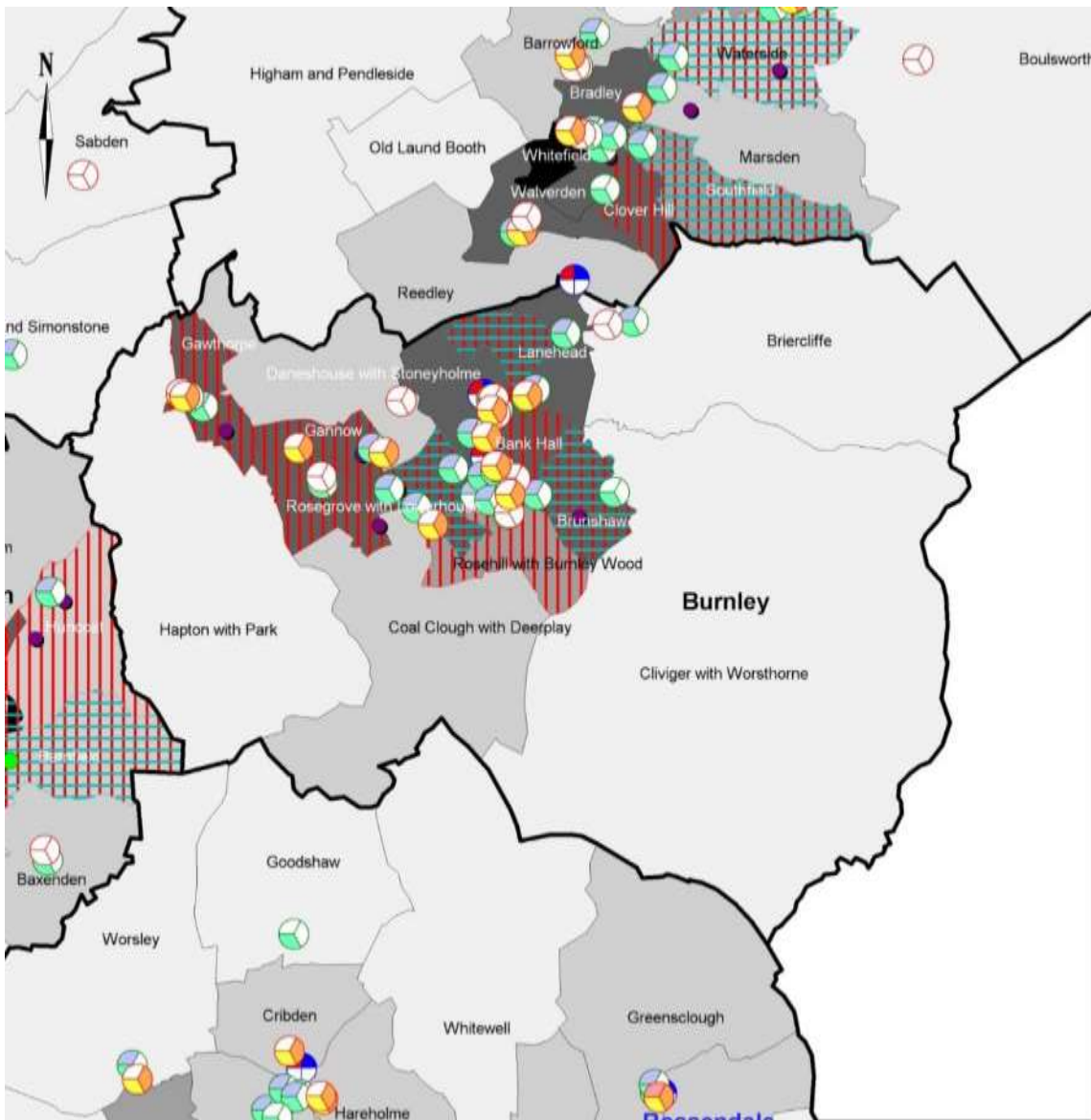
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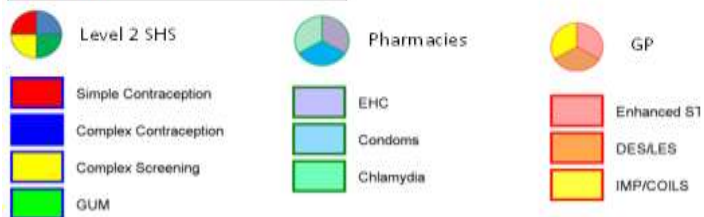
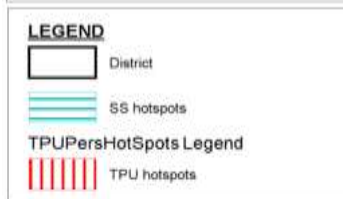
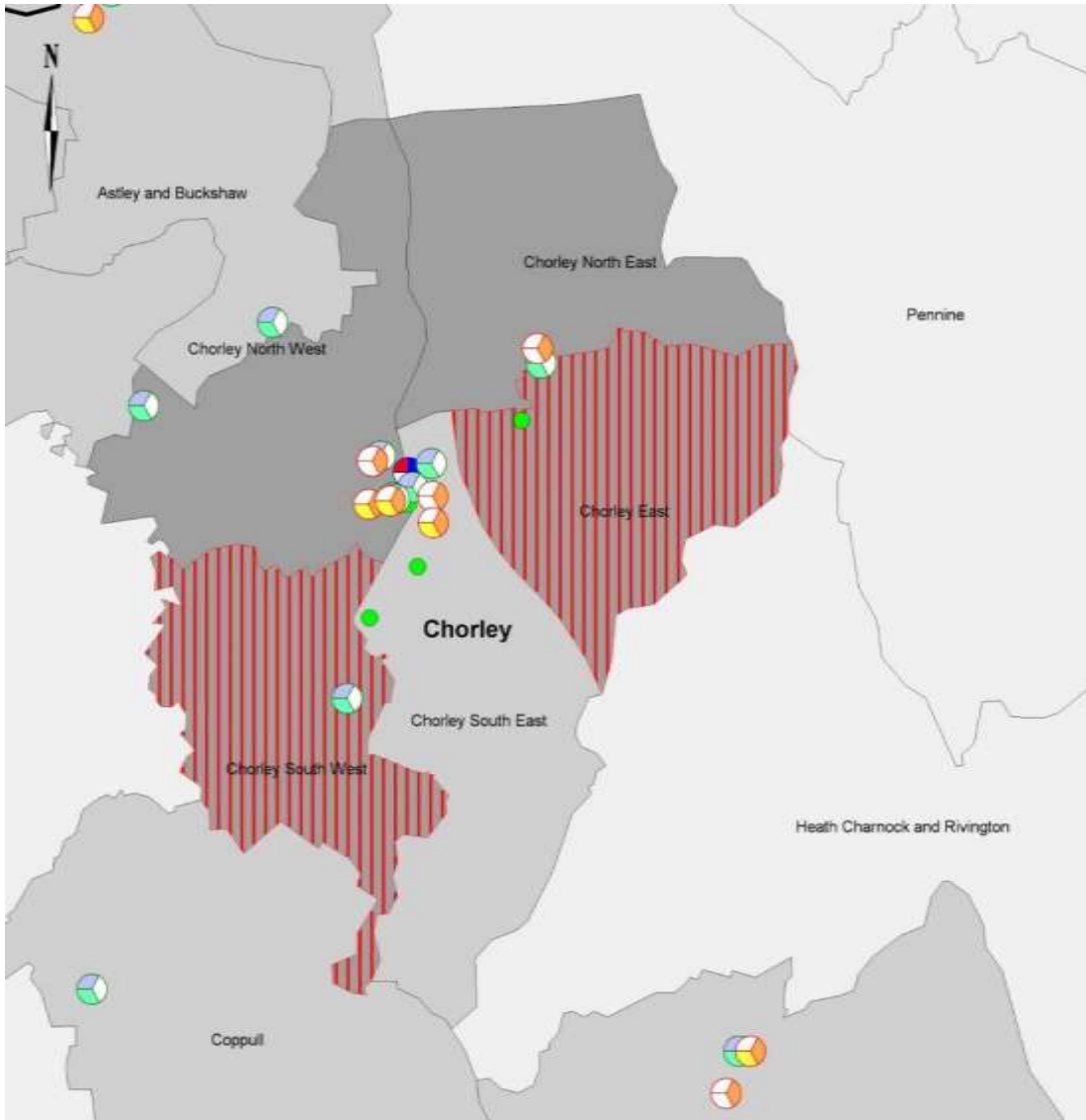
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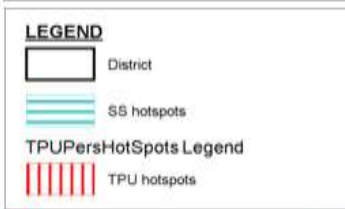
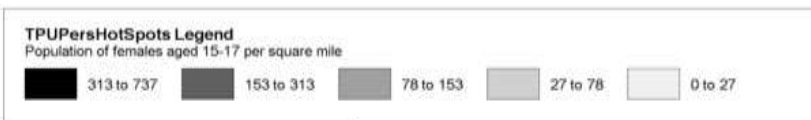
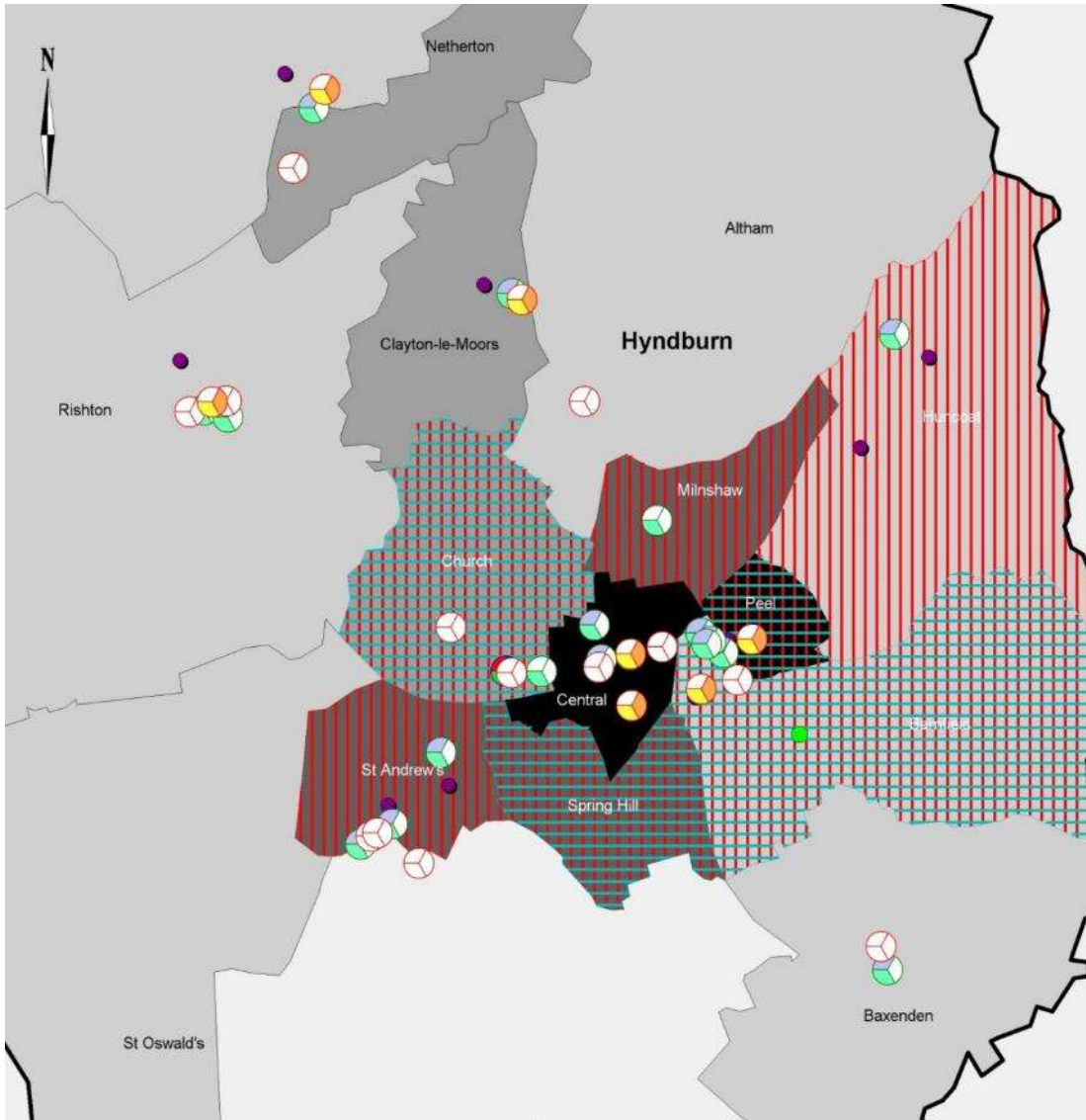
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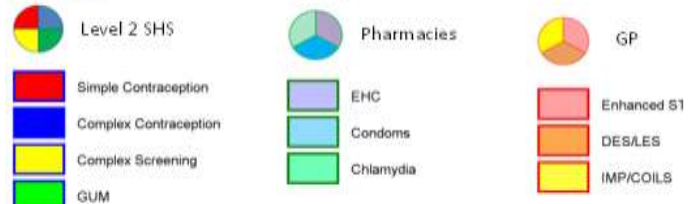
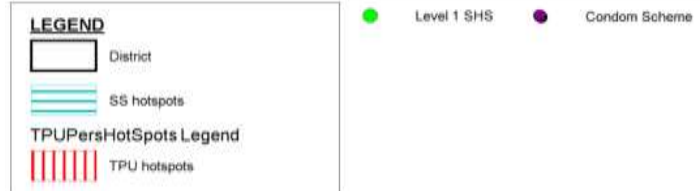
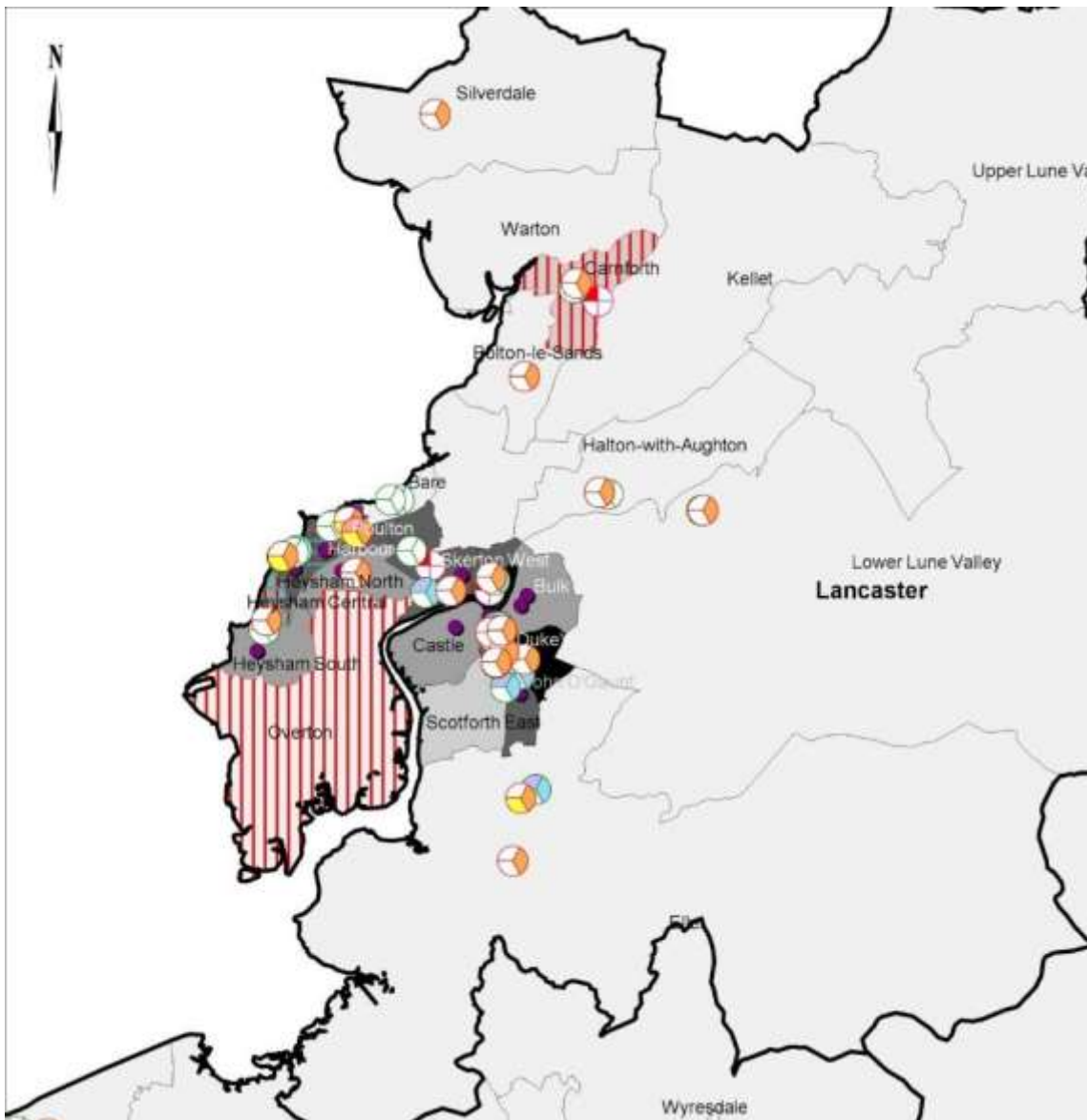
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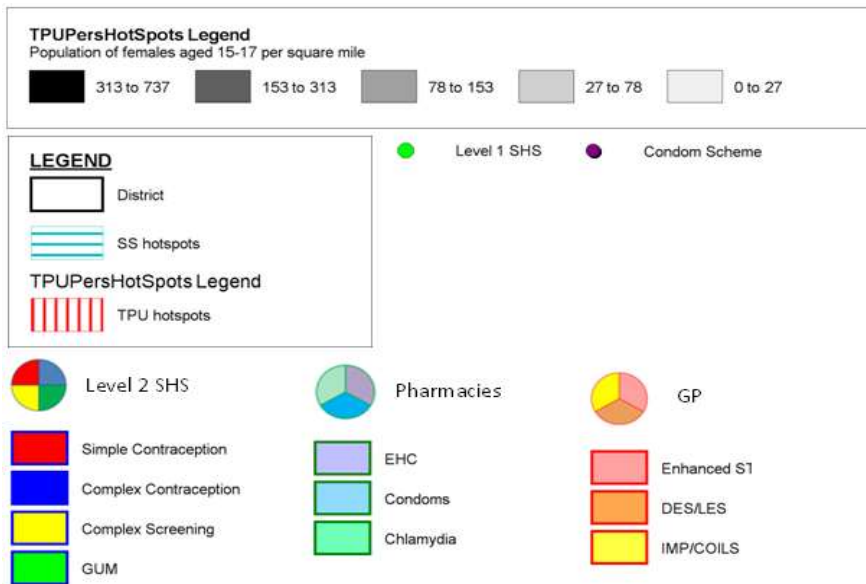
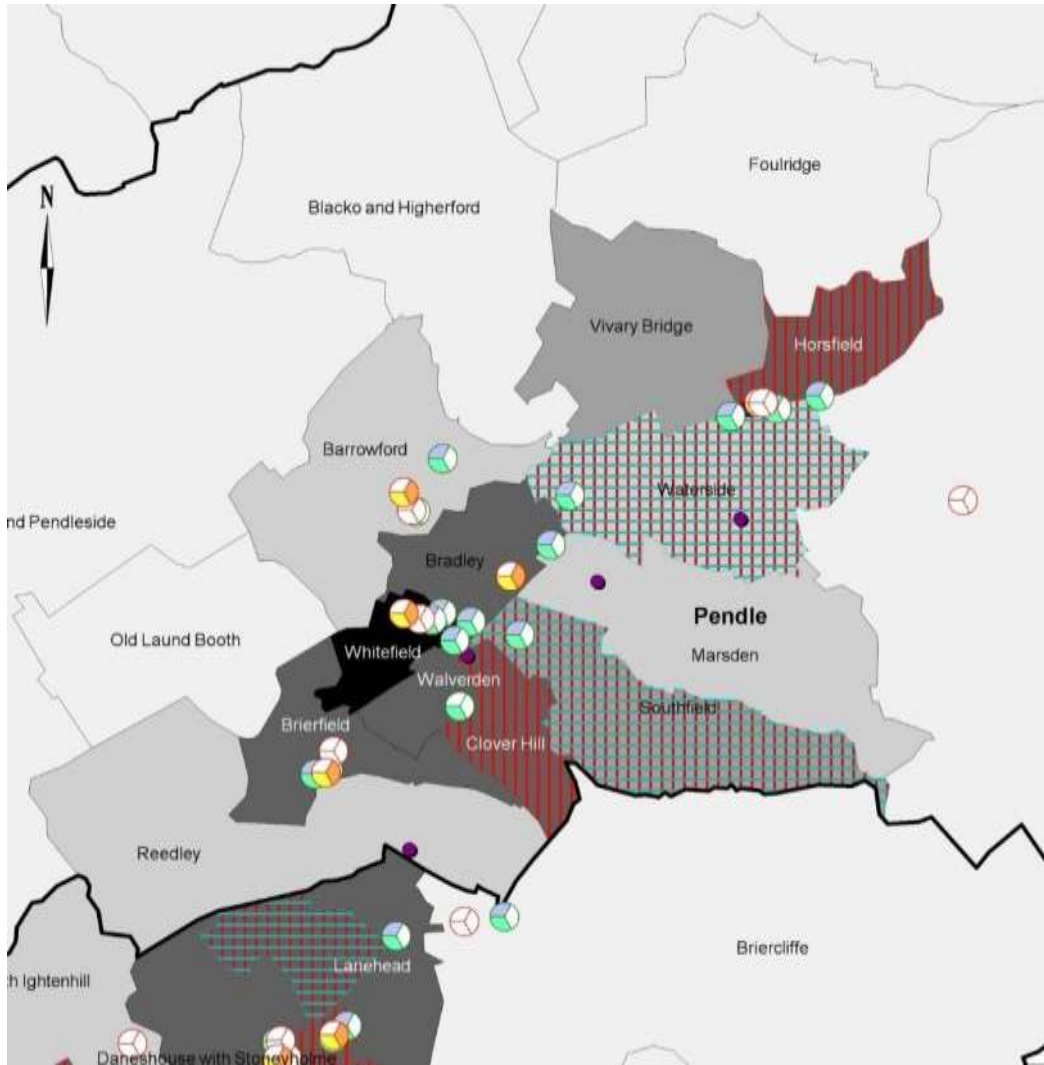
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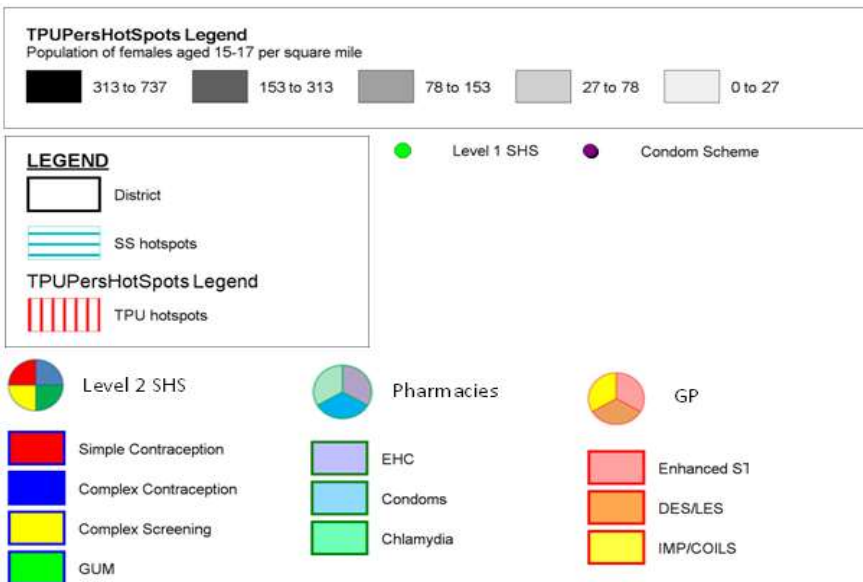
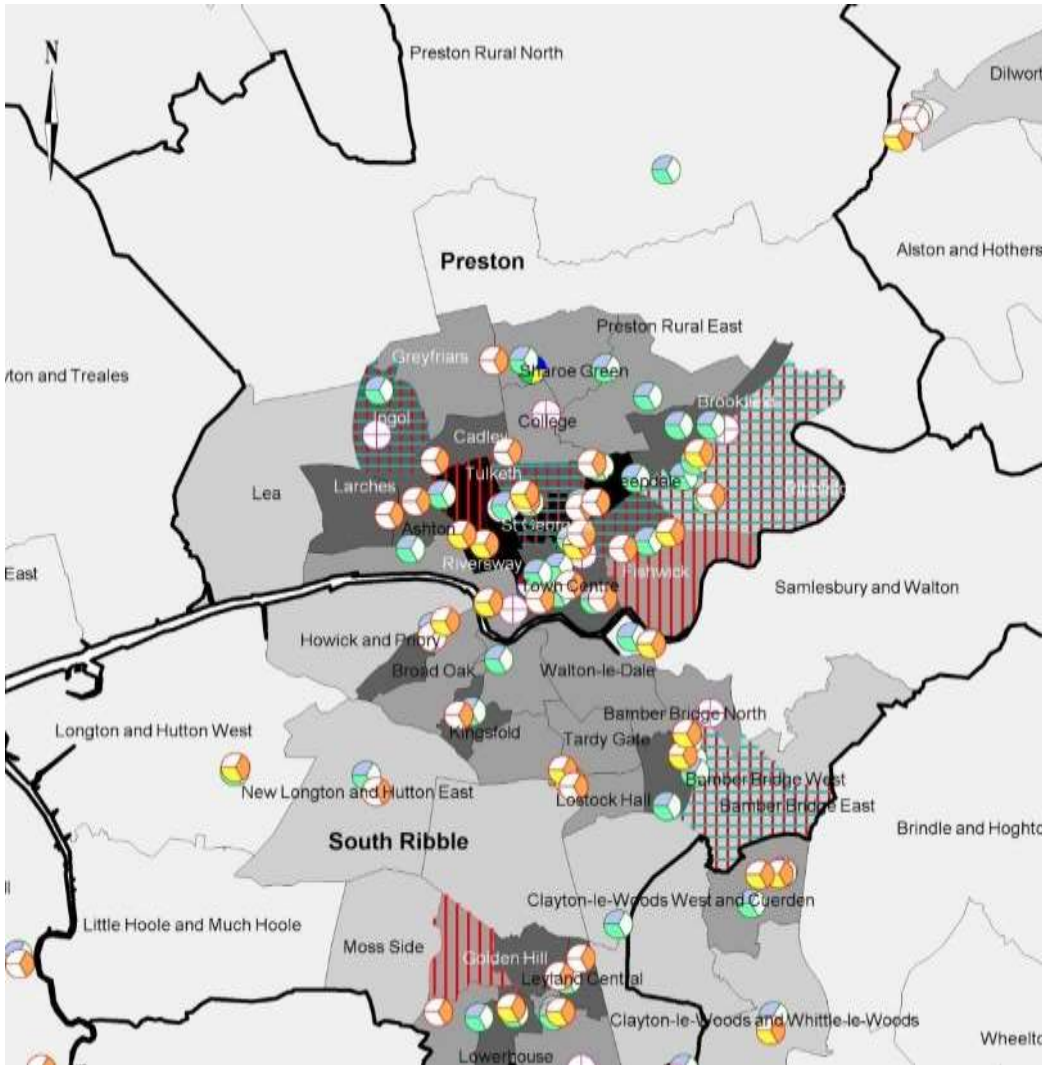
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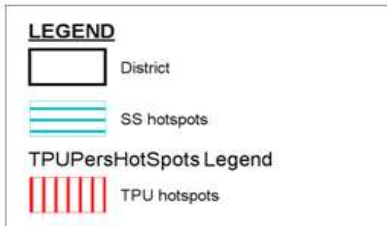
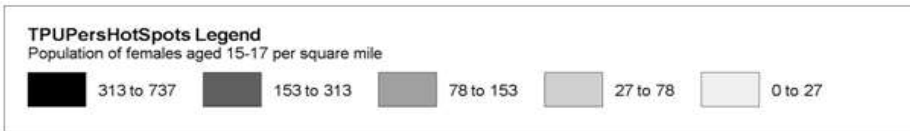
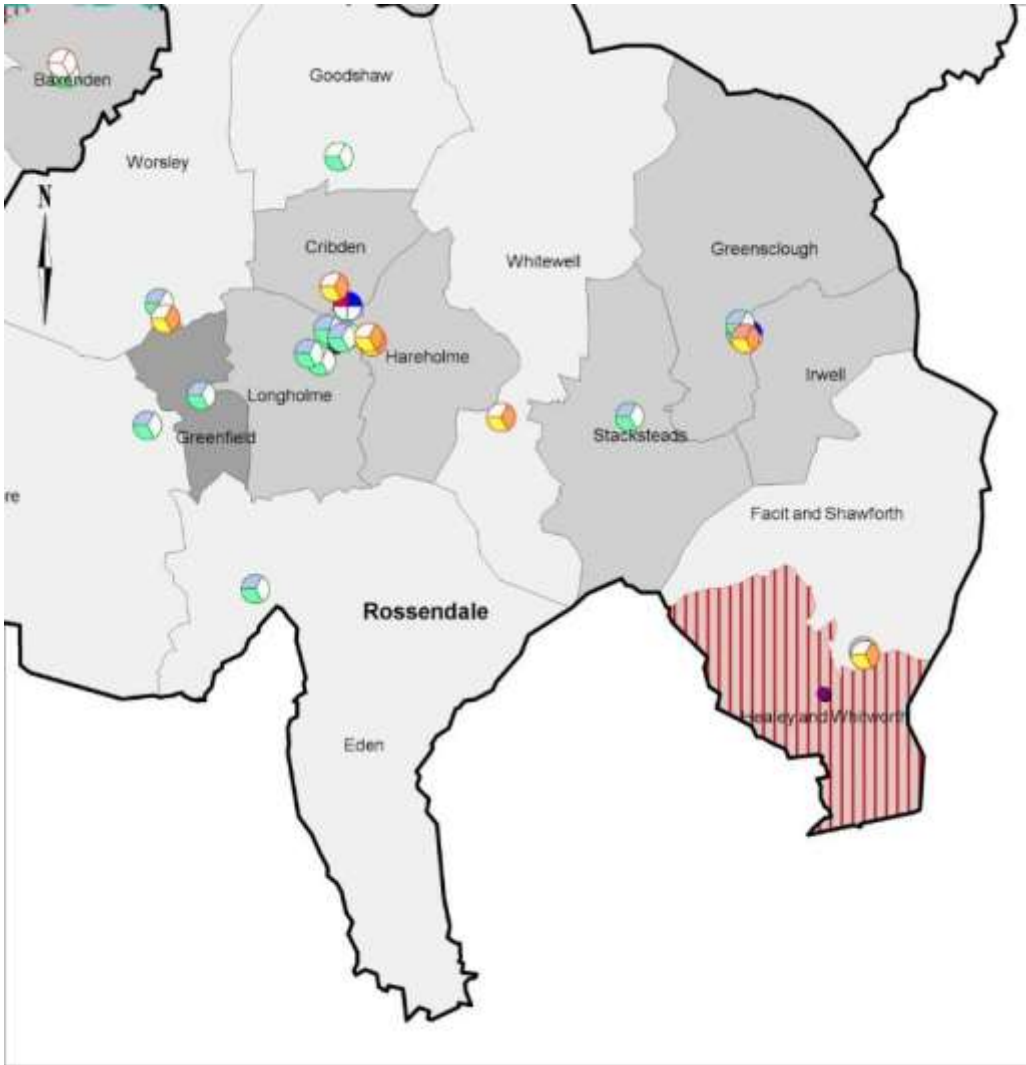
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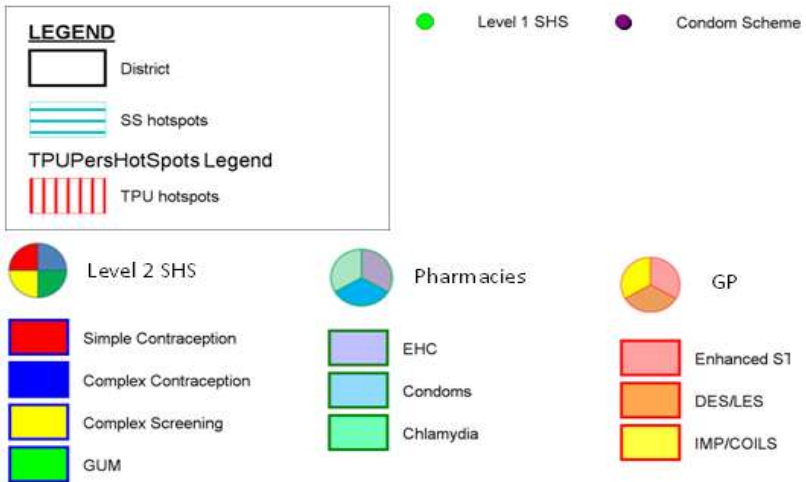
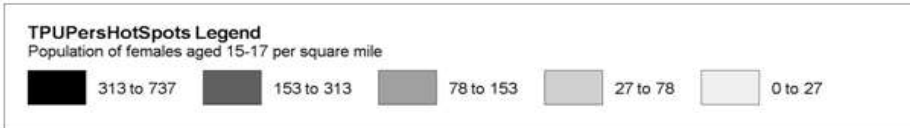
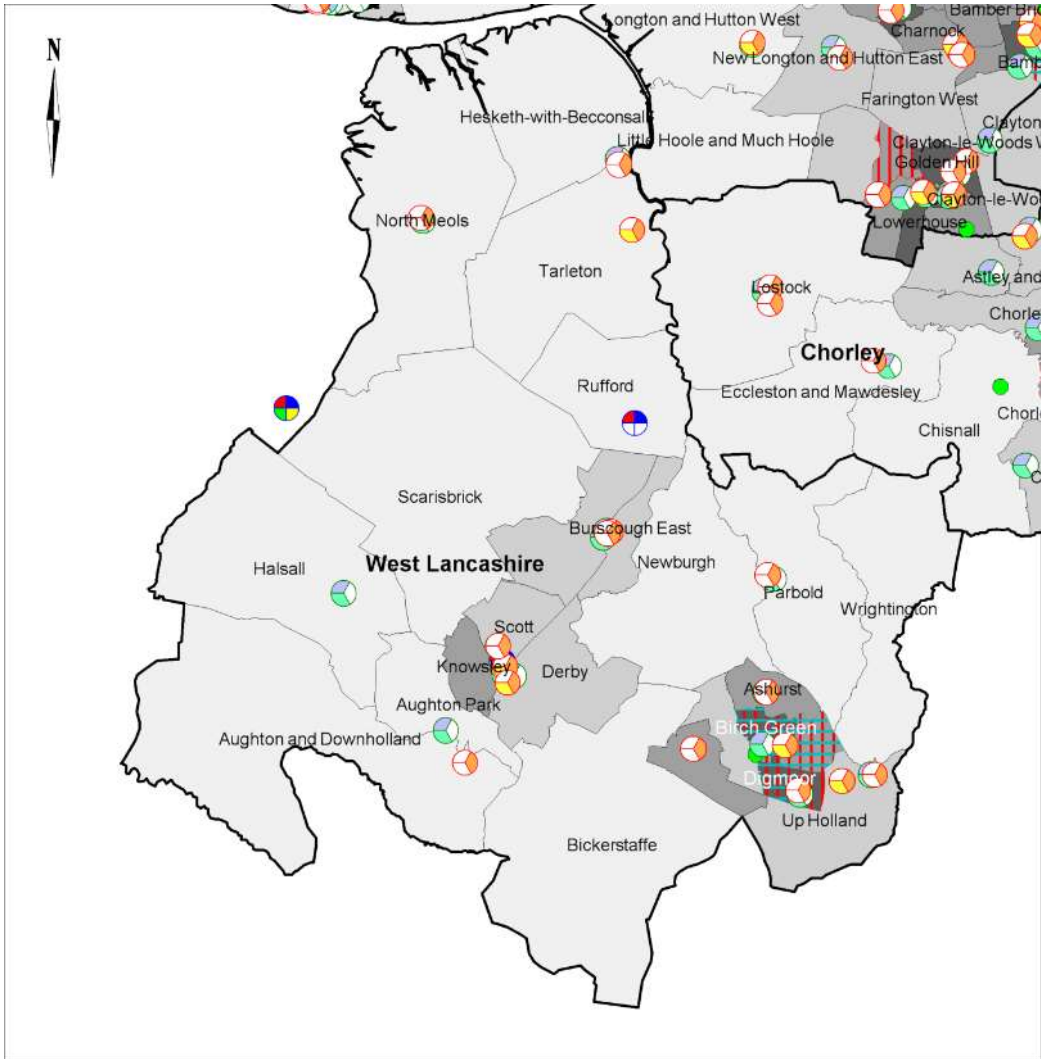

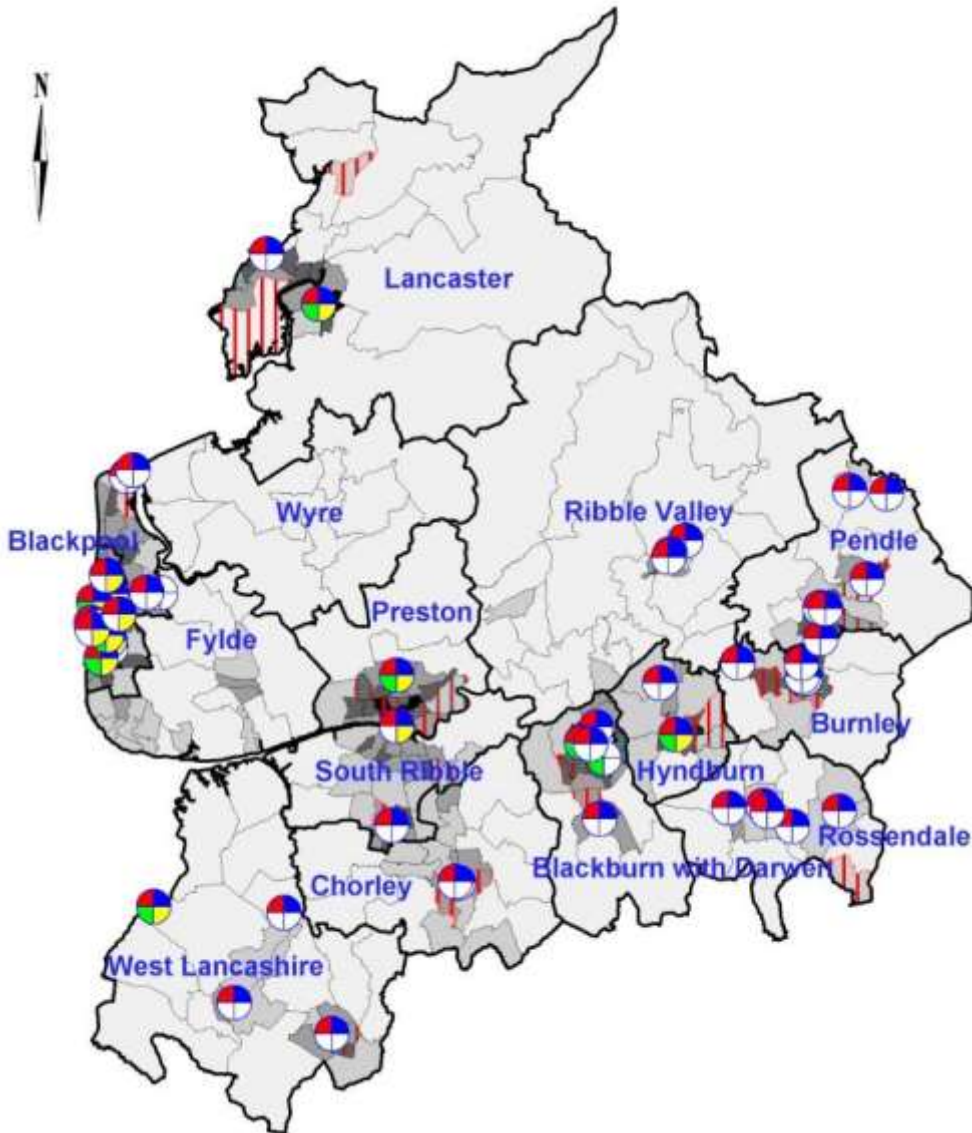


Level 2 sexual health services

We have categorised services into differing levels according to the services they offer, full definitions can be found in the methodology. Level 2 sexual health services are displayed as pie charts showing the specific services they offer and these comprise:

- Simple contraception
 - Complex contraception
 - Complex screening
 - GUM
- It is noted that in the move towards fully integrated sexual health services, all areas still have separate GUM services, with few of the contraception services, offering any screening other than Chlamydia.

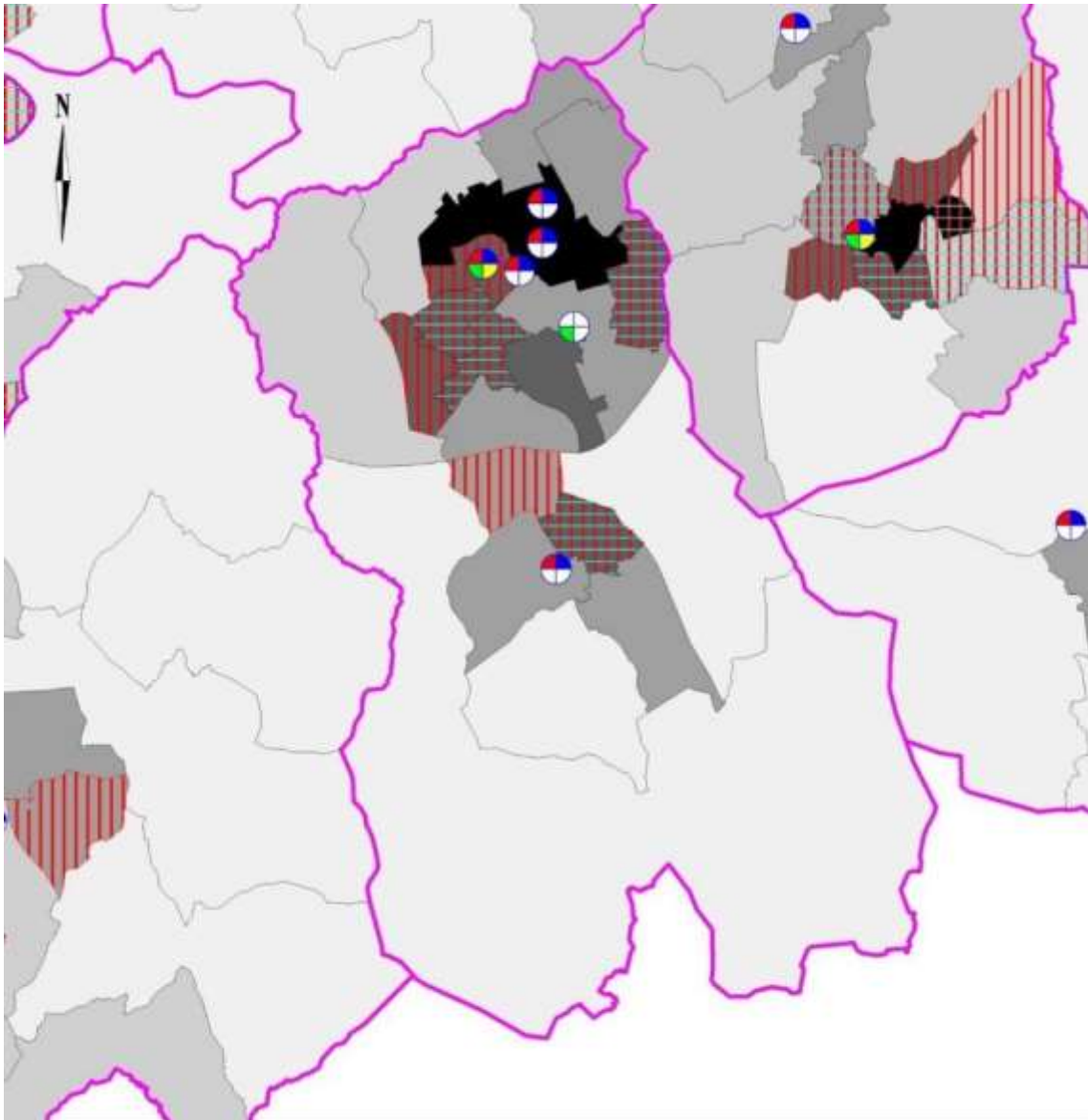

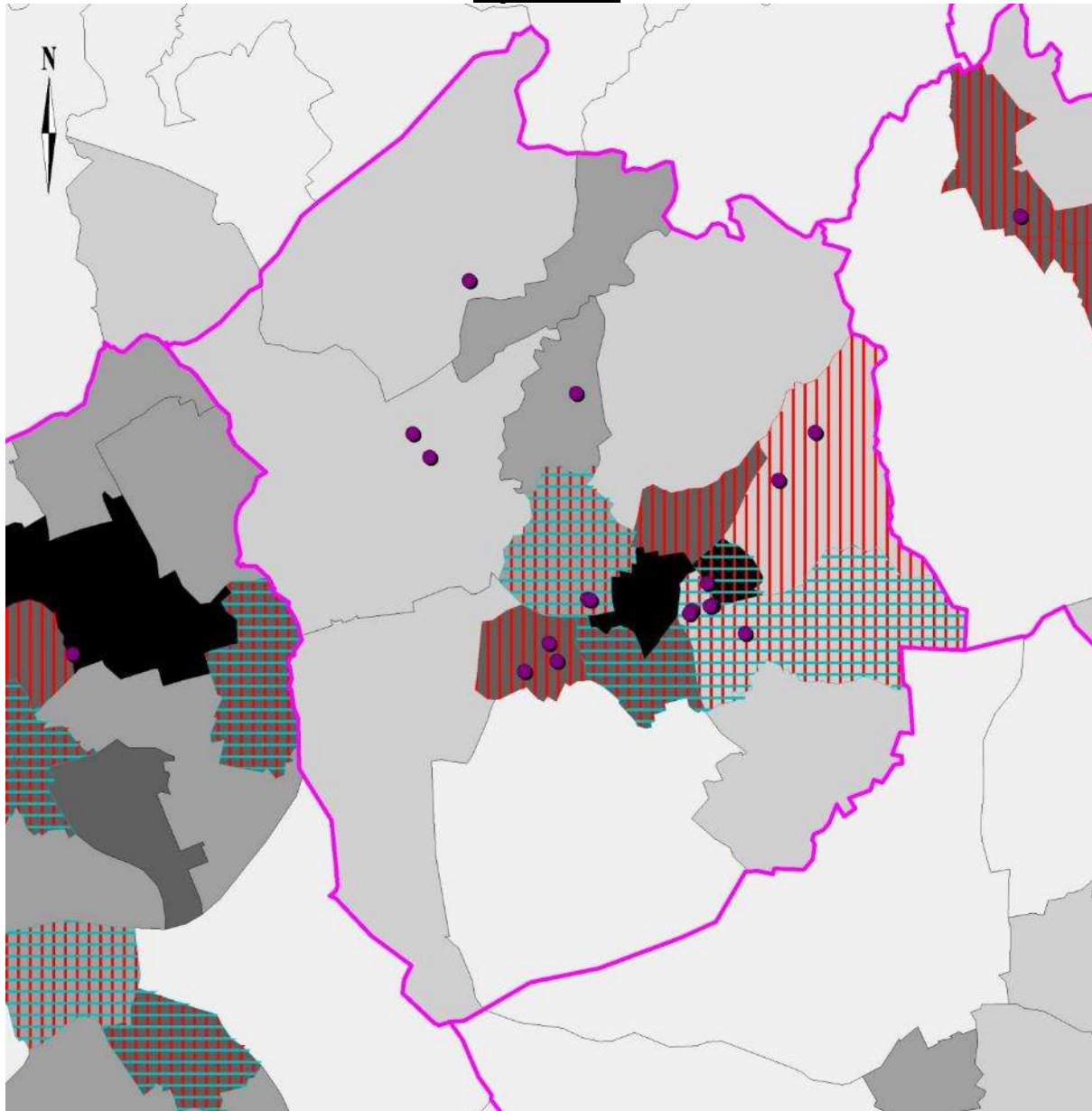


Population of females aged 15-17 per square mile

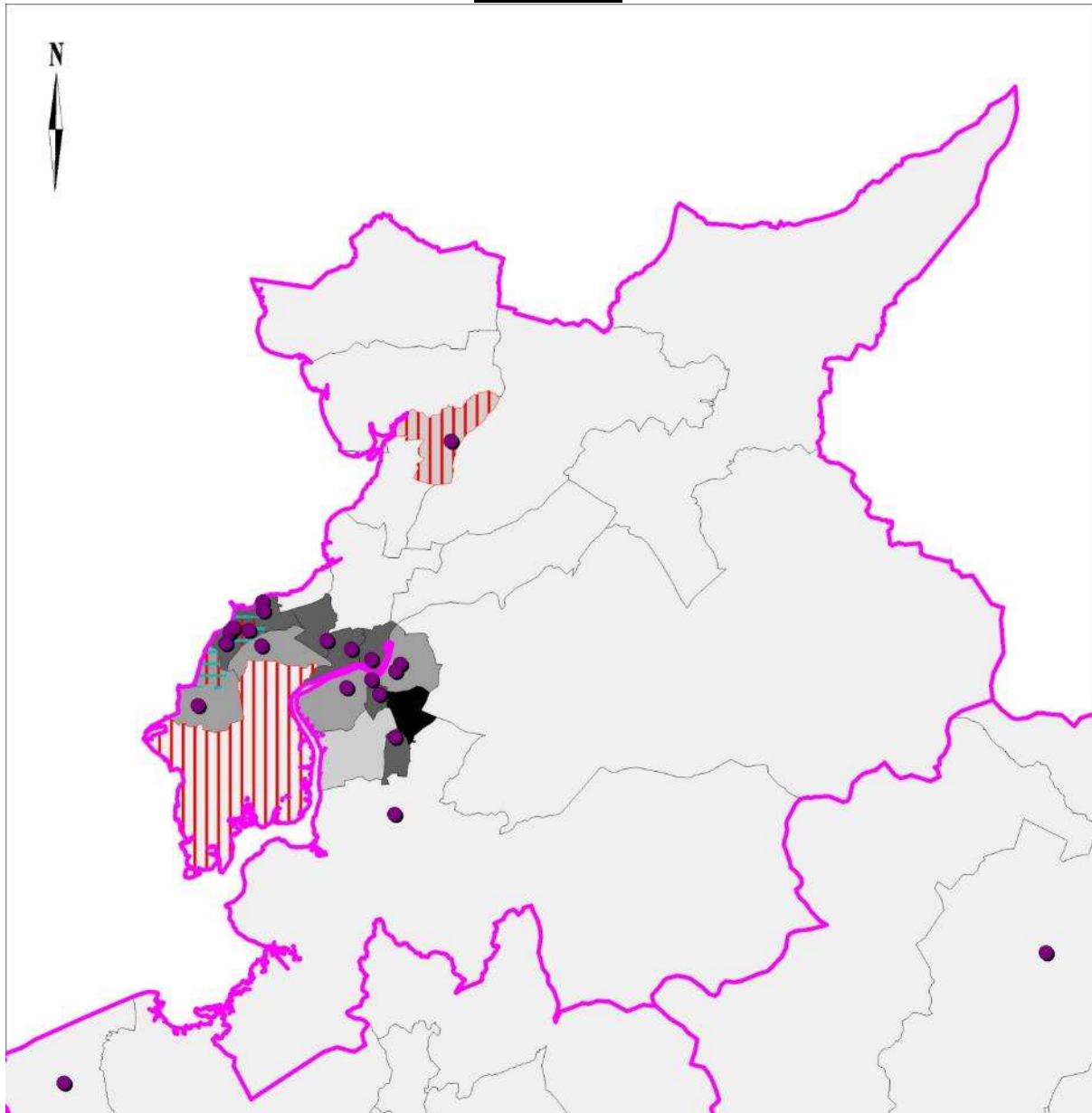


Population of females aged 15-17 per square mile





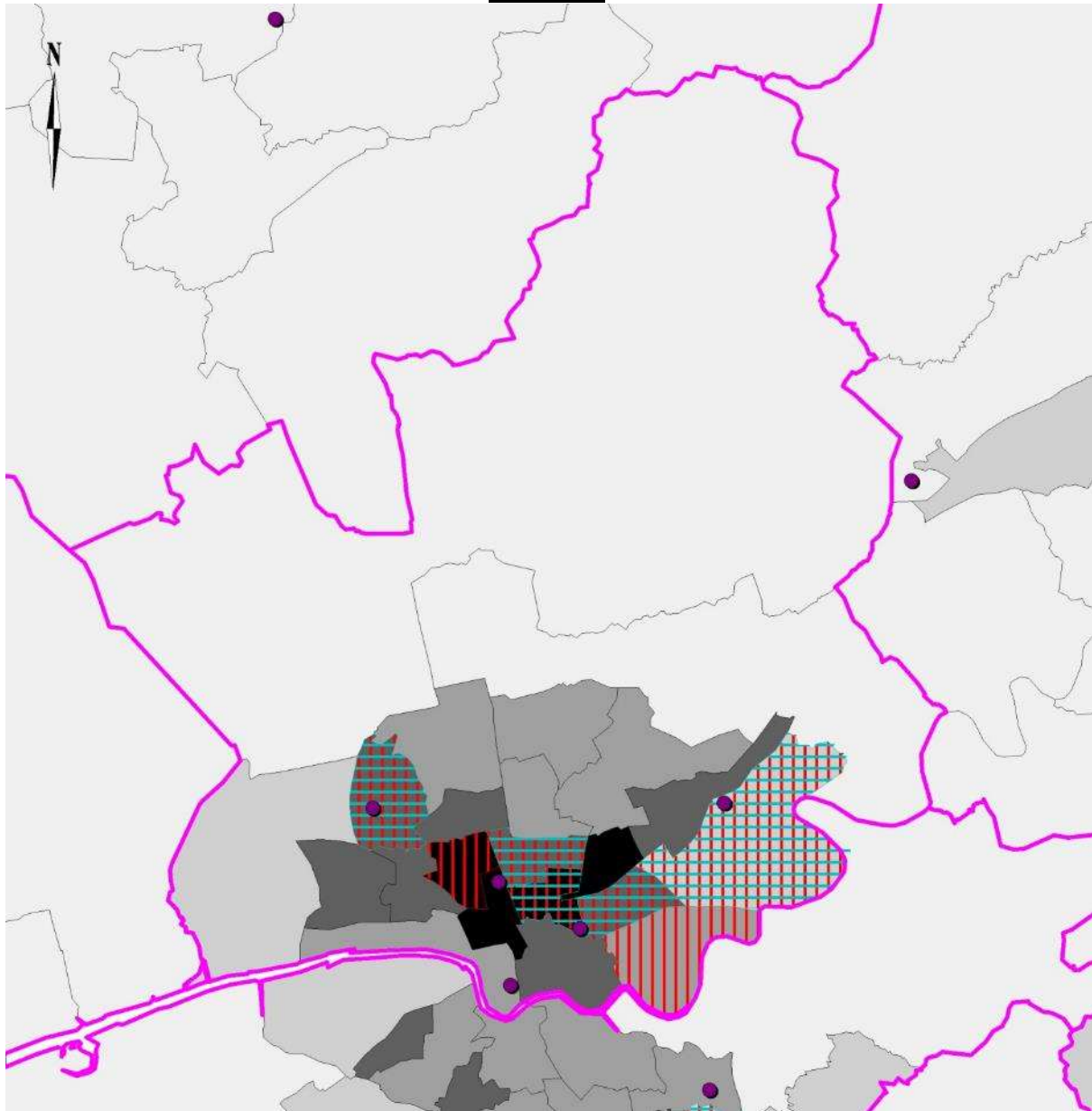


Population of females aged 15-17 per square mile

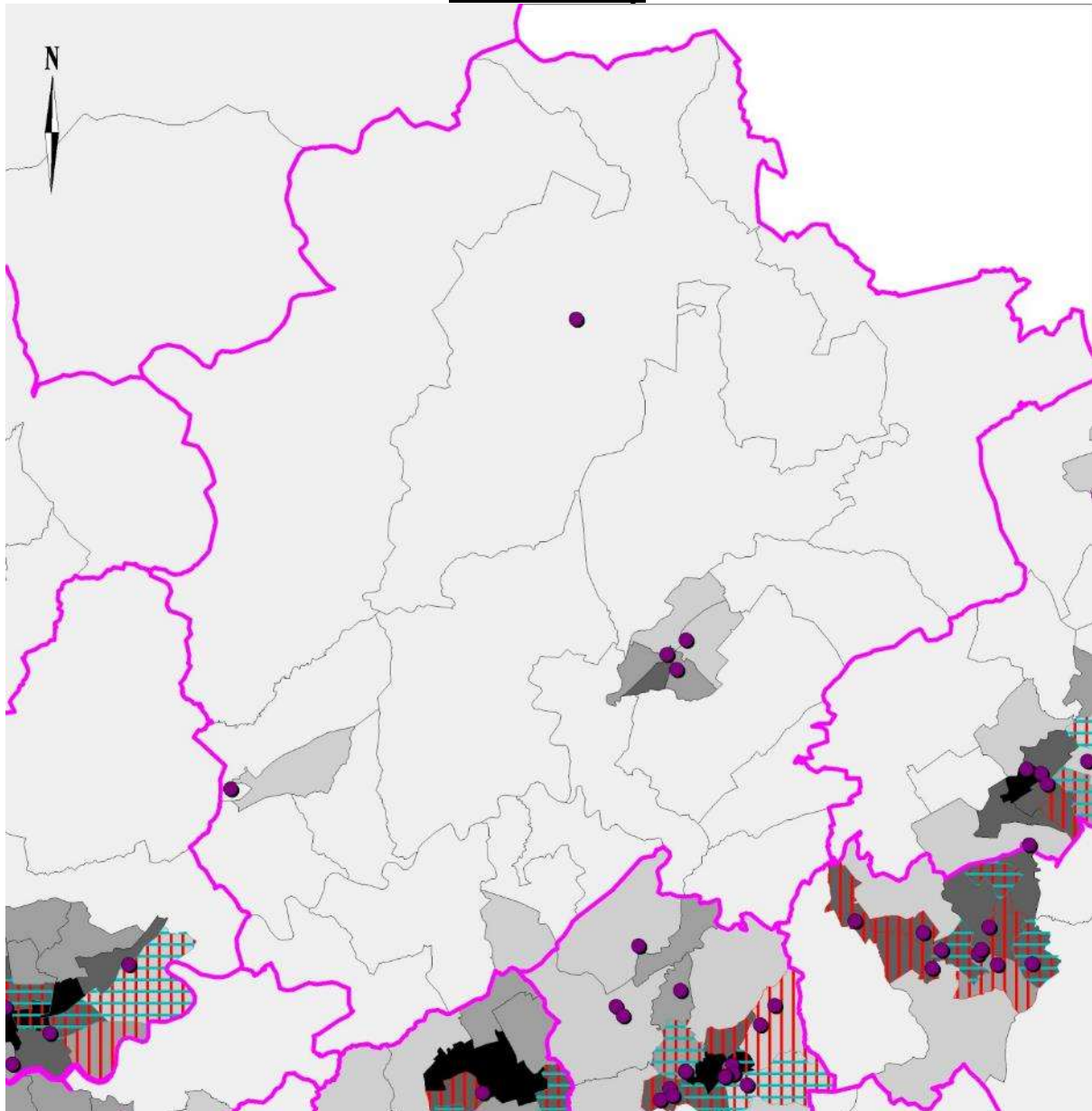


Population of females aged 15-17 per square mile





Conclusions

A summary of the findings from this mapping exercise are provided below:

- Many of the services which exist already appear to be well placed to serve those teenagers with the highest risk of conception
- Some services in the highest risk areas have comprehensive opening hours and offer a good range of sexual health services
- Some services appear to be located quite far away from teenage conceptions hotspot areas, which may limit their use to those with the highest need, especially when we consider that most of the population at risk may only walk or use public transport to access them
- Some services only open for a few hours a week or every fortnight and this is often not on the days when we would expect the highest levels of need. (Evidence shows that most teenage conceptions occur on weekend nights. Emergency hormonal contraception can be taken up to 72 hours after unprotected sex, (although the earlier it is taken the more effective it is likely to be), so services would be needed most in the 72 hours afterwards). These patterns of service might not be well understood by those in need and may act as a barrier to use
- Whilst a number of pharmacies offer Chlamydia Screening, the uptake is generally low
- Some services, although well located in terms of hotspot areas and/or target population density do not offer as full a range of services as may be needed. For example pharmacies which do not currently offer long-acting reversible contraception.
- The maps in this report show that there are patches of high population density of females aged 15-17. Some of these patches have already been identified as teenage conceptions hotspots, but others may be at risk in the future. A proactive approach to service planning is needed.
- Whilst this report does not include an analysis of Sex and Relationships, education settings are ideally placed to increase young people's knowledge. Targeted work could be rolled out to further educate young people about sex and relationships.
- Other potential future hotspot areas have been identified in the risk factors section of the main teenage conceptions in Lancashire report. These are areas which are not currently hotspots but have seven or more risk factor rates that are within the top quintile in Lancashire. These areas would benefit from preventative approaches and early intervention

as well as careful monitoring to make sure that they don't become hotspot areas in the future.

Recommendations

- This work maps the services which are currently in existence. It doesn't tell us who is using the service. To follow on from this service mapping, a full equity audit would be greatly beneficial in order to see whether the services are being accessed by those who need them most, i.e. by those from the areas with the highest levels of need.
- There is also a need to consider integration of services to ensure that young people can access a range of services, form a single point
- In planning for the future reorganisation of the NHS commissioners need to look for cost efficiencies and value for money, whilst ensuring a continuing improvement in service quality. In addition, there is a need to review all the structures, across Local Authority and PCT to ensure Sexual Health and Teenage pregnancy remain a key focus.
