An application has been made to the Registration Authority, the Lancashire County Council of County Hall, Preston, Lancashire, PR1 8XJ ('the Registration Authority) by John Douglas James Welbank and Sylvia Margaret Welbank, ('the Applicants') under Section 12 Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 ('the Regulations').

The application seeks to amend the relevant entry in the rights section of CL23 to record a transfer of a commons right in gross. The right referred to is a right to graze 26 sheep gaits over the whole of CL23, known as Ireby Fell in the Parish of Ireby. For the transfer to be recorded the Registration Authority will need to be satisfied that the supporting documents with the application have the effect of evidencing that the Applicants are the transferees of that right and the registered owners of the right of common consent to the application.

If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the evidence is sufficient it will accept the application and record the change of how the right is held. The application and supporting documentation may be inspected during the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm at the Office of the Director of Governance, Finance and Public Services, Christ Church Precinct, County Hall, Preston, PR1 8XJ.

If the application is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination in accordance with Regulations any representations will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.
