The Impact of being part of the network

The impact the project had on the individual schools and settings is described in their case studies. However there was also some impact on the group as a whole. These were:

- an increase in the confidence of all the practitioners involved in the project;
- an improvement to the planning and practice in terms of child initiated learning and development;
- an opportunity to network with colleagues. This involved working with practitioners from different settings and making links;
- professional development. Practitioners felt that they had gained:
 - \circ $\,$ a purpose and a focus
 - o time to reflect
 - o the ability to link research to practice
 - changes in the perception of child initiated learning and development for practitioners and staff teams.
