(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Burnley:

i. Yorkshire Street, Burnley from its junction with Plumbe Street to its junction with Hall Street.

ii. Centenary Way, Burnley from its junction with Yorkshire Street to its junction with Gunsmith Place.

iii. Church Street, Burnley from its junction with Yorkshire Street to its junction with Chapel Street.

- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The Order will be in force from daily from 2230 hours until 0530 hours on Monday 3rd June 2024 until Friday 21st June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures is via;

Centenary Way – Manchester Road – Rossendale Road – Accrington Road – Hameldon Approach – Burnley Barracks Interchange – Westway – West Gate – Active Way – Colne Road – Casterton Avenue – Eastern Avenue – Queen Victoria Road – Belvedere Road – Yorkshire Street and vice versa.

5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing works to be carried out.
