The above Order, made on the 8th December 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording a Restricted Byway from the junction with Haunders Lane in a generally northerly direction along an unsurfaced farm track to the junction with a public footpath recorded as 7-8-FP 3 and then along the route of the footpath to pass through Marsh Farm and then continuing along the farm access road (still recorded as 7-8-FP3) to Hannings Farm and the junction with Haunders Lane.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back Starkie Street, Preston from a point at the side of 5 Camden place travelling in a westerly direction for approximately 15 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 19th April 2022 until 1600 hours on Thursday 21st April 2022 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -
Ribblesdale place - Camden place

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities to install a new customer connection works.

THE M58 MOTORWAY (JUNCTIONS 1 - 5 CARRIAGEWAYS & SLIP & LINK ROADS & ORRELL INTERCHANGE)
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 09346363) intends to make an Order on the M58 Motorway, in the Boroughs of Sefton, West Lancashire, and Wigan, in the Counties of Merseyside, Lancashire and Greater Manchester, to enable maintenance and improvement works; to be carried out in safety.

The effect of the Order will be to impose restrictions and prohibitions on the following lengths of carriageway:

- (i) the M58 Motorway, in both directions, between Junctions 1 and 5;
- (ii) all slip and link roads leading to and from the lengths of carriageway described above;
- (iii) the Orrell Interchange.

The works are expected to take place overnight between 19:00 and 06:00 (07:00 on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Monday 2 May 2022 and ending on Friday 23 December 2022.

The duration of each restriction or prohibition will vary depending upon the nature of the work being undertaken on each occasion.

During any road closures traffic will be diverted via alternative junctions of the M58 Motorway and local roads. These diversions will be clearly indicated by traffic signs throughout the area.

The restrictions will not apply to emergency services or special-forces vehicles, and the prohibitions will not apply to emergency services, works, winter maintenance, or traffic officer vehicles. The restrictions and prohibitions will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.

The Order comes into force on 1 May 2022 and will expire on 23 December 2022.
