(STRAND ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Strand Road, Preston from its junction with Port Way travelling in a northerly direction for approximately 30 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 hours until 2200 hours on 7th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Liverpool Road – Leyland Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Sapphire Utilities on behalf of United Utilities to replace a manhole frame and cover works in the carriageway.
