NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this order.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle (except for event participants) from proceeding over the following lengths of road: Albert Road, the entire length Church Street, the entire length Walton Street, from its junction with Craddock Street to its junction with Church Street Market Street, the entire length Craddock Street, the entire length Newton Street, from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Craddock Street
- 2. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
- The prohibition will be operative from 1100 hours on Saturday 29th June 2024 until 2359 hours on Sunday 30th June 2024. (Or, at such time as, the last competitor has passed a point specified in the first column of the schedule to this notice.)

Access will be maintained via marshal points for residents and businesses.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable the holding of the Colne Soapbox Race.
