(SHAROE GREEN LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sharoe Green Lane, Preston from its junction with Clanfield to its junction with Tower Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1800 hours on 30th June 2024 until 0600 hours on 1st July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Tower Lane – Broadwood Drive – South Drive - Brooklands Drive

6. An alternative route for HGVs affected by the closure is via:-

St Vincents Road – A6 Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out the installation of a new puffin crossing and resurfacing works.
