## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(SHAROE GREEN LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sharoe Green Lane, Preston from its junction with Clanfield to its junction with Tower Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1800 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 until 0600 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Tower Lane – Broadwood Drive – South Drive - Brooklands Drive

6. An alternative route for HGVs affected by the closure is via:-

St Vincents Road – A6 Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out the installation of a new puffin crossing and resurfacing works.
