


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHURCH AVENUE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN
BOROUGH) (PRIORITY CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a priority crossing in Church Avenue, Baxenden, Accrington, from a point 8.3 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Manchester Road for a distance of 4 metres in a south westerly direction.



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Statement of Reasons

Pedestrian and cyclist crossing priority at the side road is reinforced by the proposed road markings and aims to improve compliance to Highway Code Rule H2. Provision of a marked priority full set back reduces the risk of a collision.
