The route is crossed by Footpath 7-8-FP2 and continues in a broadly east south easterly direction along the watercourse through to Liverpool Road (A59).

With the exception of the bounded stone surfaced track carrying the footpath 7-8-FP2 the Order route is currently largely unusable as it is recorded within the old boundaries of the historical route known as Watery Lane within which the watercourse is located.

The total length of the route is 1.04 kilometres and the width of the route varies between 2.5 metres and 10 metres.
