(U1034 RUFF LANE, ORMSKIRK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U1034 Ruff Lane, Ormskirk from A570 Knowsley Road, Ormskirk to U47330 Beach Meadow, Ormskirk.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0800 hours and 1800 hours, from Monday 24th June 2024 until Tuesday 23rd July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. Alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Diversion Route A

U1034 Ruff Lane, Ormskirk – C117 Scarth Hill Lane, Ormskirk – A570 St Helens Road, North of Park Road – A570 Knowsley Road, Ormskirk and vice versa.

Diversion Route B

U1034 Ruff Lane, Ormskirk – A570 St Helens Road, North of Park Road – C117 Scarth Hill Lane, Aughton – U1034 Ruff Lane, Ormskirk.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway surface dressing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
