(U965 PLEX LANE, HALSALL, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U965 Plex Lane, Halsall from the Southern boundary of the property named The Old Grannary Barn to the Western boundary of the property named Lowland Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1000 hours on Monday 24th June 2024 until 1500 hours on Wednesday 3rd July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U965 Plex Lane, Halsall – A5147 Southport Road, Downholland –
A5147 Wanishar Lane, Downholland – A5147 Delf Lane,
Downholland – B5195 Broad Lane, Downholland – C115 Bye Lane,
Downholland – C104 Rosemary Lane, Downholland and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow electrical connection diversion works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West.
