OXFORD STREET, ACCRINGTON HYNDBURN, DISTRICT/BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Oxford Street, Accrington from Hyndburn Road to Blackburn Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The Order will be in force daily from 07:45 hours to 16:00 hours on Sunday 29th September 2024 until Thursday 3rd October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The probations will only be operative when indicated on site by presence of the appropriate traffic signals in accordance with the Traffic Signals Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 6. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 7. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway reconstruction works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
