NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Newgate Lane, Whitestake, from its junction with Chain House Lane to its junction with Woodland Court.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours to 1700 hours on Wednesday the 26th of June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Pope Lane – Penwortham Way – Chain House Lane And vice versa.
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained..

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out.
