NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Between John Street – St Marys Road, Bamber Bridge from James Street, Bamber Bridge to the southern boundary of the rear of property 140 Station Road, Bamber Bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 31st July 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 2nd August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. Alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure are via:-

Clockwise Diversion

St Marys Road, Bamber Bridge – Aspden Street, Bamber Bridge

Anticlockwise Diversion

James Street, Bamber Bridge – Aspden Street, Bamber Bridge

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water connection replacement works to be carried out.
