

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BETWEEN JOHN STREET – ST MARYS ROAD, BAMBER BRIDGE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Between John Street – St Marys Road, Bamber Bridge from James Street, Bamber Bridge to the southern boundary of the rear of property 140 Station Road, Bamber Bridge.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 31st July 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 2nd August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. Alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure are via:-

Clockwise Diversion

St Marys Road, Bamber Bridge – Aspden Street, Bamber Bridge

Anticlockwise Diversion

James Street, Bamber Bridge – Aspden Street, Bamber Bridge

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water connection replacement works to be carried out.
