(B5321 TORRISHOLME ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of B5321 Torrisholme Road, Lancaster for a distance of approximately 20 metres either side of the rail bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2200 hours on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 until 0600 hours on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-B5321 Torrishome Road – Scale Hall Lane – A589 Morecambe Road – A6 Owen Road – B5321 Torrisholme Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Rail Bridge examination works to be carried out.
