- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 2 to 18 Bracewell Street, Burnley from the rear of property number 4 Bracewell Street to the rear of property number 8 Bracewell Street.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1030 hours on Saturday 1st June 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 5th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair to excavation required to rebuild defective chamber in the carriageway to be carried out.
