

Correct positioning of A-Boards

Dear Headteacher

Thank you for working with us to reduce parking issues at your school. Your school has been supplied with "THINK! Stopping here could endanger a child's life" A-Boards to help prevent illegal parking.

Picture shows correct positioning of A-Boards



Please bear in mind when using the A-Boards outside school that they must not be placed on the road and should be positioned to highlight existing restrictions and not be used to prevent legal parking. The A-Boards should be positioned on the pavement by an employee of the school, taking into account space for anybody that may wish to pass (e.g. space for pushchairs or mobility scooters). Please note that School Crossing Patrols are under instruction not to get involved in the placement or removal of A-Boards.

Lancashire County Council will not accept responsibility for incidents that occur due to incorrect or inconsiderate positioning of A-Boards. Also, please ensure that the A-Boards do not exceed the time (8am – 6pm) shown on the signs outside school and are not used overnight or during school holidays.

Thank you for your continued support to keep the area outside your school a safer place.

If the A-Boards are no longer required, you can arrange for them to be collected by a member of the Road Safety Team.
