GREEN END AVENUE, EARBY, PENDLE BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Green End Avenue, Earby from its junction with New Road to its junction with Aspen Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0745 hours until 1600 hours on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 until Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
New Road – Green End Road – Aspen Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow resurfacing works to be carried out.
