(MANCHESTER ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Manchester Road, Preston from its junction with St Austin's Place to its junction with Arno Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1630 hours on 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Queens Street – London Road – Frenchwood Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to carry out a carriageway safety scheme including the installation of road humps, drainage works and carriageway resurfacing.
