(TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION) (TEMPORARY NO WAITING) (TEMPORARY NO LOADING/UNLOADING) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any person to cause or permit any motor vehicle or cycle from proceeding at a speed exceeding the stated temporary speed restriction over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Fylde:

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to exceed the speed limit of 40MPH over the following lengths of highway:
  - i. Wild Lane, Westby with Plumptons from its junction with B65410 Whitehill Road to its merging with North Houses Lane.
  - ii. North Houses Lane, Lytham St Annes from its merging with Wild Lane to its merging with B5410 Lytham St Annes Way.
- 2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle to wait at any time on the following lengths of highway:
  - i. Wild Lane, Westby with Plumptons from its junction with B65410 Whitehill Road to its merging with North Houses Lane.
  - ii. North Houses Lane, Lytham St Annes from its merging with Wild Lane to its merging with B5410 Lytham St Annes Way.
- 4. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024.

**AND FURTHER,** to prohibit any loading/unloading on the lengths of highway specified in article 3.

The temporary prohibitions are necessary to enable major highway development works.
