

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(NEPS LANE, PAYTHORNE, RIBBLE VALLEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Neps Lane, Paythorne from its junction with Kiln Lane travelling in a north easterly direction for approximately 90 metres.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0745 hours on 10th June 2024 until 1545 hours on 5th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Settle Road – Station Road – Church Lane – Forest becks brow – Settle Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Lancashire County Council to construct a 30 metre long retaining wall due to a land slip.
