(BARTON LANE, BARTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Barton Lane, Barton from its junction with Langley Lane travelling in an easterly direction for approximately 620 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on 22nd July 2024 until 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Jepps Lane – Garstang Road – Bilsborrow Lane – Silk Mill Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out asset maintenance works.
