GABLE 44 HAWTHORNE ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Gable 44 Hawthorne Road, Burnley from the rear of 28 Rosehill Road to its junction with Hawthorne Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Hawthorne Road – Lansdowne Close and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow lead pipe replacement works to be carried out.
