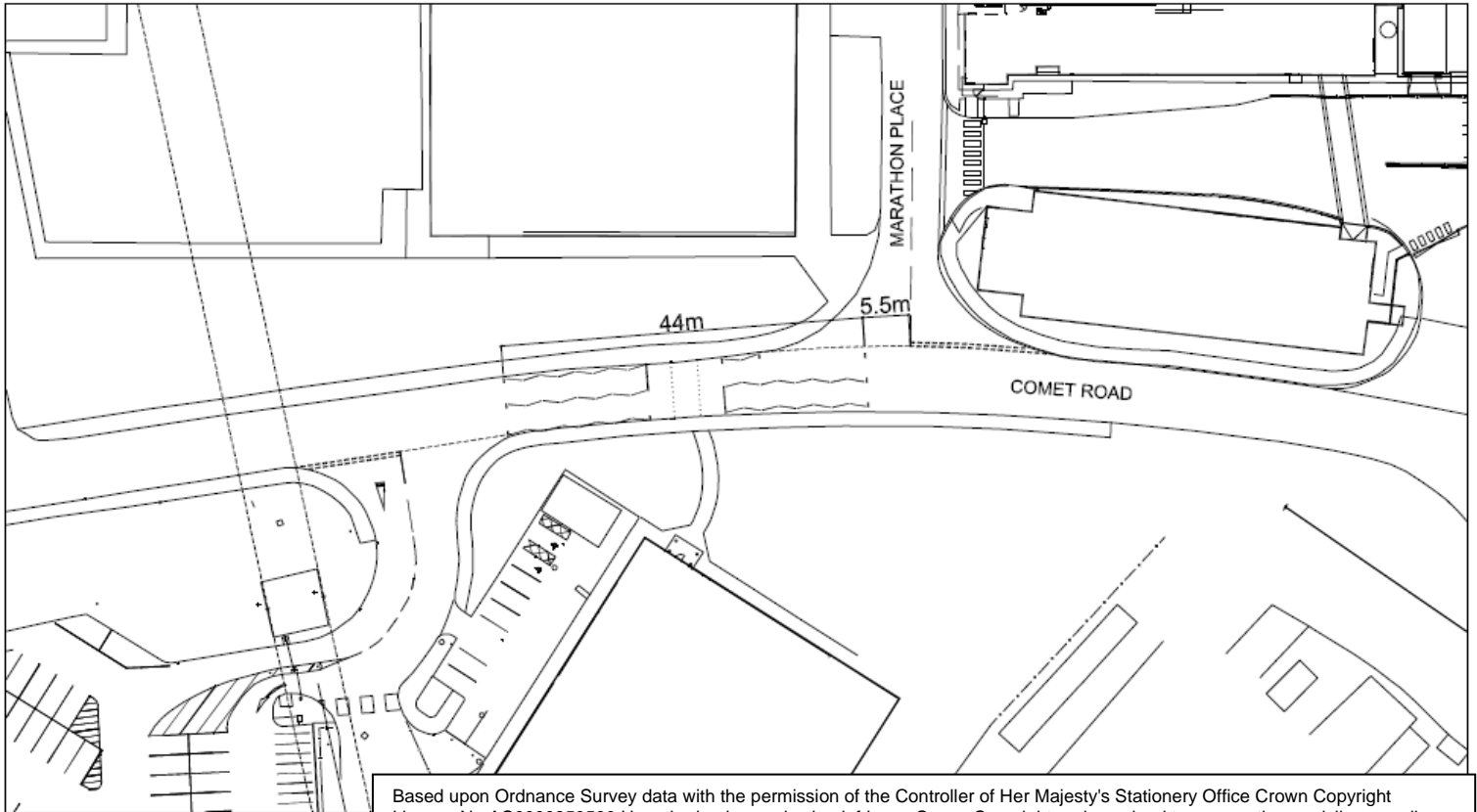


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COMET ROAD, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE
BOROUGH) (PUFFIN CROSSING)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a puffin crossing in Comet Road, Leyland, from a point 5.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Marathon Place for a distance of 44 metres in a westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a factory development which will introduce further traffic movements within the area of Comet Road. The purpose of the proposed Puffin Crossing is to provide a safe crossing point for pedestrians to promote sustainable travel and promote social inclusion.
