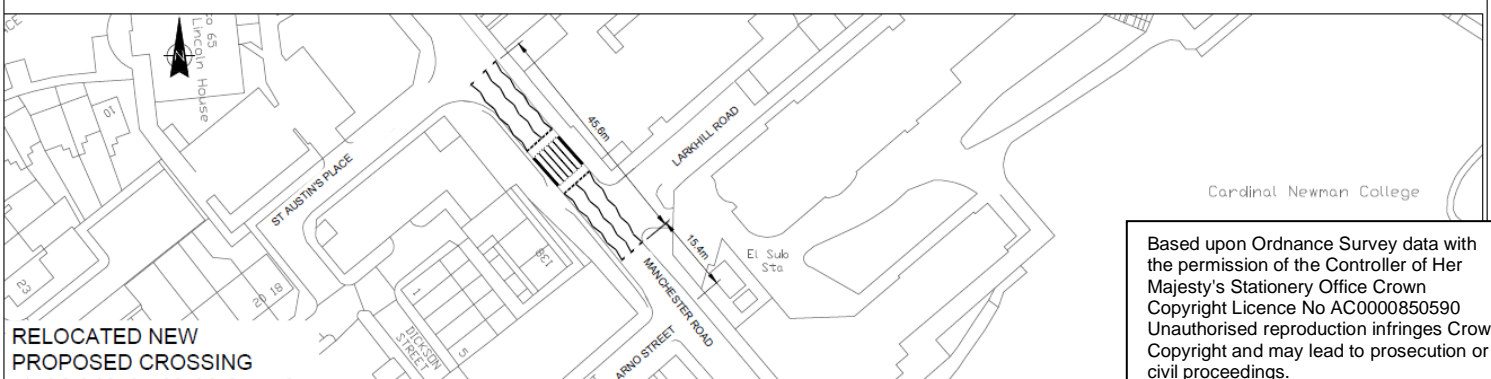
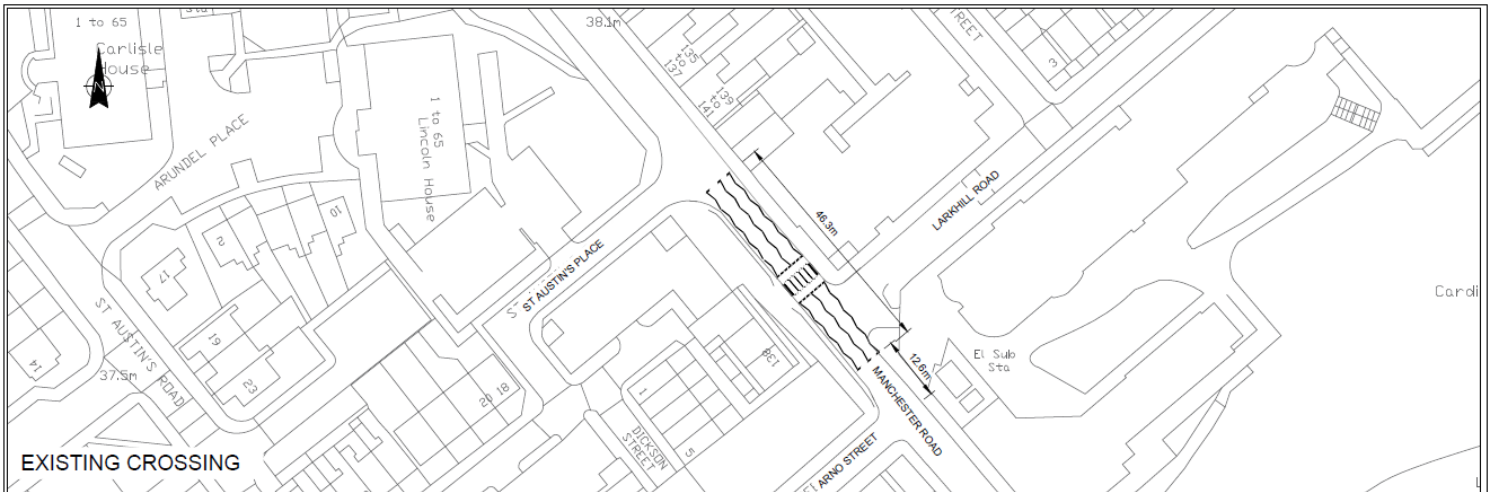


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(MANCHESTER ROAD, PRESTON, PRESTON**  
**CITY) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to remove and make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- Remove a zebra crossing in Manchester Road, from a point 12.6 metres north west of its junction with the Centreline of Arno Street for a distance of 46.3 metres in a north westerly direction.
- Introduce a zebra crossing in Manchester Road, from a point 15.4 metres north west of its junction with the Centreline of Arno Street for a distance of 45.6 metres in a north westerly direction.

**Statement of Reasons**

The requirement for the zebra crossing improvements, which is to be widened to 10m from its current 7.2m width, is due to the expansion of Cardinal Newman College, which is opening a new building in September in order to accept a greater number of students. The increased width will allow a greater number of pedestrians to cross safely at the same time, reducing the delays to traffic and improving safety for all road users.
