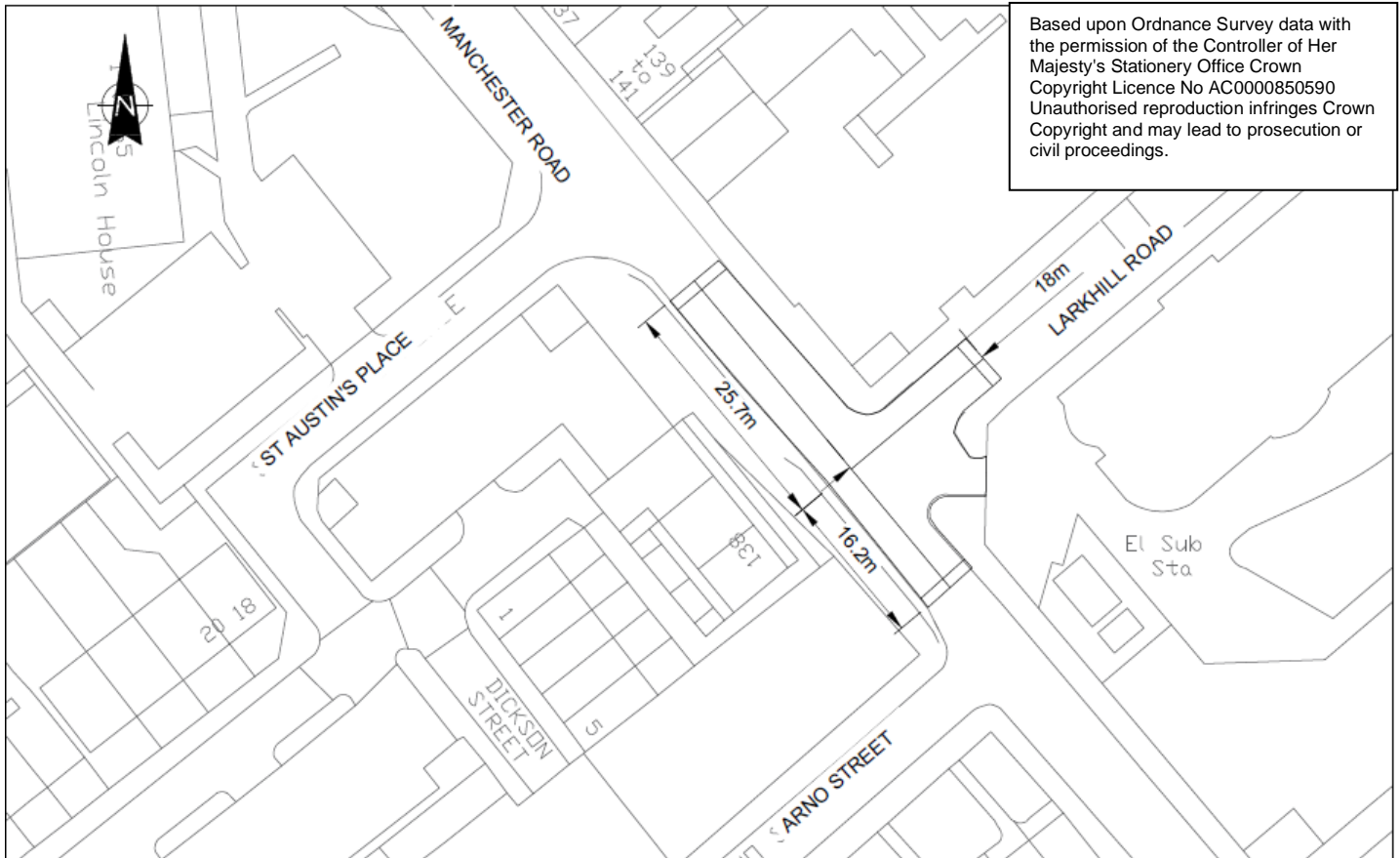


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LARK HILL ROAD AND MANCHESTER ROAD,
PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (JUNCTION TABLE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a junction table in the following locations:

- Manchester Road, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Lark Hill Road and Manchester Road for a distance of 25.7 metres in a north westerly direction.
- Manchester Road, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Lark Hill Road and Manchester Road for a distance of 16.2 metres in a south easterly direction.
- Lark Hill Road, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Manchester Road for a distance of 18 metres in a north easterly direction.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 90 mm.



Statement of Reasons

The provision of a raised junction table has been requested by Cardinal Newman College, due to serious accidents involving pedestrians at the junction (recorded between 2020 and 2023) and on the adjacent zebra crossing. Although the junction of Manchester Road and Lark Hill Road is within an existing 20mph zone, the visibility of the junction is poor and it is located between cushions that are currently over 80m apart, and the existing cushions are not fully visible on the northbound approach due to a gradient and a large number of parked vehicles. The proposed junction table is to be provided in the interest of safety of all road users.
