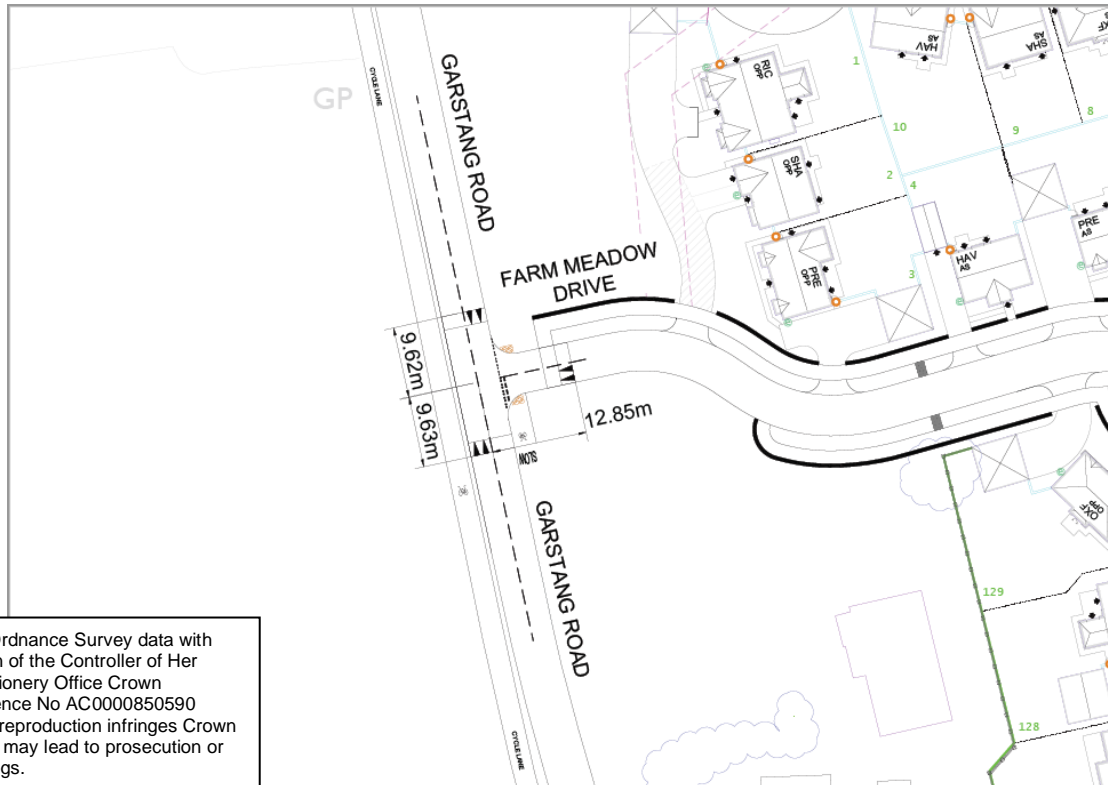


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(GARSTANG ROAD AND FARM MEADOW DRIVE,
PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (JUNCTION TABLE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a junction table in the following locations:

- 1) Garstang Road, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Farm Meadow Drive and Garstang Road for a distance of 9.62 metres in a northerly direction.
- 2) Garstang Road, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Farm Meadow Drive and Garstang Road for a distance of 9.63 metres in a southerly direction.
- 3) Farm Meadow Drive, Preston, from the intersection of the centreline of Garstang Road for a distance of 12.85 metres in an easterly direction.

The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 65mm.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are being pursued as part of a s278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development which will introduce further traffic movements around Garstang Road, Broughton. The purpose of the proposed raised junction table at the junction of Farm Meadow Drive to Garstang Road is to slow traffic and allow safe passage of pedestrians due to the increase in traffic from the new housing development.
