Following further consultation, Cadent and/or National Grid has withdrawn its objection to these activities.

Dear Mr Moore,

Thank you for your correspondence dated 18th August 2020 relating to the application to record a bridleway along the route hash-marked on the accompanying document. As requested I have highlighted the extent of my property and annotated three points of particular concern.

The proposed deviation from our access at point marked "A" is an imposition into my property for no apparent reason, rather than following the line of the existing footpath along the property boundary. There is no access here and the route is blocked by many well established trees and shrubs. Furthermore, at the point marked "D", there is an established pend of approximately 24m². It completely blocks the proposed route and is home to plentiful wildlife including newts.


Although the point marked "C" does not directly adjoin my property it is important to note that this strip of land is closely sandwiched between a high domestic fence to one side and a steep fall to a brook on the other, interspersed with large established trees. I have measured the immovable boundaries of this strip of land which at several points is only 1.1m wide. Photographic evidence of this and the other points mentioned above can be provided if required.

It seems that the applicant has not actually visited the site, as my points are immediately obvious from a casual survey of the areas in question. I would like to have this letter noted as a strong objection to the proposal and would be very keen for the relevant officers to make a site visit.
