## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(HIGHER RAMSGREAVE ROAD, RAMSGREAVE, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Higher Ramsgreave Road, Ramsgreave from a point outside number 13 travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2024 until 1700 hours on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Barker Lane - Ramsgreave Drive - Ramsgreave Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utility to carry out sewer repair works.
