(HOLDEN LANE, BOLTON BY BOWLAND, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Holden Lane, Bolton by Bowland, from opposite Outer Lodge to a point approximately 100 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative between the hours of 0930 and 1530 on Thursday the 1st of August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Barret Hill Brow – Grindleton Road – Easington Road –
Wigglesworth Road – Tinklers Lane – Holden Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out asset testing works.
