(HOLDEN LANE, BOLTON BY BOWLAND, RIBBLE VALLEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Holden Lane, Bolton by Bowland, from opposite Outer Lodge to a point approximately 100 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative between the hours of 0930 and 1530 on Thursday the 1st of August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Barret Hill Brow – Grindleton Road – Easington Road – Wigglesworth Road – Tinklers Lane – Holden Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Openreach on behalf of British Telecom to carry out asset testing works.
