(U290 BESCAR LANE, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U290 Bescar Lane, Scarisbrick for a distance of 15m either side of Bescar Lane Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2330 hours on Saturday 13th July 2024 until 0700 hours on Sunday 14th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not possible owing to the fact that U290 Bescar Lane, Scarisbrick is a no through road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow plain line tamping at the level crossing to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
