(A506 LIVERPOOL ROAD, WEST OF STANLEYGATE, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of A506 Liverpool Road, West of Stanleygate from the South West boundary of property number 44 to the North East boundary of property number 26.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours until 1600 hours on Saturday 13th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C123 Long Lane, Bickerstaffe – C123 Long Lane, Aughton – C117 Scarth Hill Lane, Aughton – C117 Scarth Hill Lane, Ormskirk – A570 Ormskirk Road, Clock House – A506 Liverpool Road, West of Stanleygate and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals UK on behalf of BT.
