

## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(C176 HILL HOUSE FOLD LANE AND C174 ROBIN HOOD LANE, WRIGHTINGTON, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the West Lancashire Borough:-
  - i. C176 Hill House Fold Lane, Wrightington from C176 Courage Low Lane, Wrightington to C174 Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington.
  - ii. C174 Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington from C176 Hill House Fold Lane, Wrightington to the entrance to Robin Hood Farm.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily between 0830 hours and 1500 hours from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Only one closure to be implemented at any one time.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. Alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closures are via:-

### **C176 Hill House Fold Lane, Wrightington**

C174 Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington – A5209 Hall Lane, Wrightington – C176 Moss Lane, Wrightington and vice versa.

### **C174 Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington**

C176 Hill House Fold Lane, Wrightington – C176 Moss Lane, Wrightington – A5209 Hall Lane, Wrightington – C174 Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow telegraph pole maintenance works to be carried out by Dutton Traffic Management on behalf of BT.
