(COOTE LANE, LOSTOCK HALL, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Coote Lane, Lostock Hall from Leyland Road, Lostock Hall for a distance of 15m in a South Westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 hours on Monday 8th July 2024 until 2300 hours on Tuesday 9th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Leyland Road, Lostock Hall – Leyland Road, Penwortham – New Lane, Penwortham – Pope Lane, Penwortham – Penwortham Way, Penwortham – Penwortham Way, Farington – Flensburg Way, Farington – Farington Road, Farington – Watkin Lane, Lostock Hall – Leyland Road, Lostock Hall and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer network desilting works to be carried out.
