(VICARAGE ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Vicarage Road, Poulton le Fylde from its junction with Station Road for approximately 125 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Thursday 8th August 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic (**except HGVs**) affected by the closure is via:

Station Road – Victoria Road – Breck Road

Diversion Route for HGVs is via: Station Road – Lower Green – Garstang Road West – Blackpool Old Road – Queen Square – Chapel Street – Breck Road – Victoria Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new telegraph pole works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
