

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

(SEGAR STREET, MEDLAR WITH WESHAM, FYLDE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Segar Street, Medlar with Wesham from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Garstang Road South.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Rawlinson Street – Garstang Road South

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
