(RIDING BARN STREET, CHURCH, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed in a South Westerly direction over that length of Riding Barn Street, Church from its junction with Elmfield Street to its junction with Hyndburn Road, Accrington.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0920 hours on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Traffic proceeding in a North Easterly direction is unaffected by this closure.**
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a gas escape to be carried out by Cadent Gas.
