**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
FOOTPATH FROM BLACKBURN ROAD TO NORMAN ROAD, OSWALDTWISTLE
DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2023**

The above Order, made on the 12 July 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording footpath from a junction with Blackburn Road immediately to the east of West End Methodist Church, Oswaldtwistle running south between the eastern boundary of the Methodist Church and the rear boundaries of properties 372 Blackburn Road and 2 - 12 Norman Road for a distance of 30 metres before turning to continue in a more south easterly and then easterly direction to exit onto Norman Road north of 14 Norman Road.

The total length of the route is 0.06 km and the width is 3 metres.

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LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL BURNLEY ROAD, CLAYTON LE MOORS, HYNDBURN/BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2003
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of A678 Burnley Road, Clayton le Moors from its junction with A680 Whalley Road for a distance of 456 metres in a northerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force from 08:00 to 16:00 hours on Sunday 10th September and Sunday 17th September 2023 to or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
5. Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order.
6. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
7. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WILLOWS LANE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Willows Lane, Accrington from junction of Dale Street to junction of Corporation Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1000 hours to 1500 hours on Sunday 17th September 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: Blackburn Road - B6231 Market Street - Rhyddings Street - Catlow Hall Street - Fielding Lane - Broadfield - Cross Edge - Willows Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow detailed bridge examination works to be carried out by Centurion Site Services.

The above Order, made on the 12 July 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording footpath from a junction with the back street to the rear of Ripon Road in a south easterly direction bounded on either side by garden fences for a distance of 50 metres exiting onto a part of Aspen Lane recorded as Bridleway BW1105300.
