(SPEN LANE, TREALES ROSEACRE AND WHARLES, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Spen Lane, Treales Roseacre and Wharles for 20 metres either side of Spen Railway Bridge. Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1600 hours on Monday 30th September 2024 until Friday 11th October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Spen Lane - Kirkham Road - Carr Lane - Dowbridge B5192 –
New Hey Lane - Spen Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation removal works to be carried out by Network Rail.
